6970	Parvin Kapila	At East Health Trust (PHO) we run group based smoking cessation treatment programmes (7 weeks for one hour a week), we know that making Auckland Smoke Free will help/support/prompt people not to smoke, especially outside pubs and cafes.
6973	Eleanor Grey	I think making Auckland smokefree is a fantastic idea, there is nothing worse than walking down the street and having to breathe in smoke from someone else's cigarette. I can't wait for Smokefree NZ 2025! I think that all public areas should be smokefree, as well as cars as it's not fair on other occupants. Most people are considerate enough not to smoke in the car but I have definitely seen a few driving around that do and this is very unfair to the passengers, especially children!
6975	Moana McKeen	Would like parks to be smokefree.
6977	Ruth Marck	After just returning from Europe and seeing the extent of smoking there, New Zealand is certainly much further along the track to becoming smoke free. However, we still have a way to go and we should take the opportunity to be a world leader in achieving a smoke free environment.
6981	June Poole	Making Howick smokefree, including the village, parks and beaches should be our local aim.
