4. There is also considerable work to be celebrated in our community and that we are thankful for
- The School Public-Private Partnership challenges which caused the two new schools' grounds and courts to be unavailable to our community have been resolved for the immediate term. This has taken 2 years of advocacy and we thank the Board and wider Council for their advocacy support alongside us.
 - The initial community consultation that we joint led with Council was an incredible success with huge participation, energy and constructive feedback.
 - A number of community groups and initiatives have been mobilised for which many have received various forms of support through Council/Local Board. These include the new community garden, our school-based youth work, a range of community gatherings and various neighbourhood groups, the community advocacy, and the improvement of the proposed Coastal Linear Park to incorporate more of our community needs and aspirations.
 - The provision of the Headquarters Building and Sunderland Lounge (and that the work is now underway on the Sunderland Lounge).
 - The Upper Harbour Board investigating how it could try and meet some of the youth and recreational needs of our community through existing infrastructure.

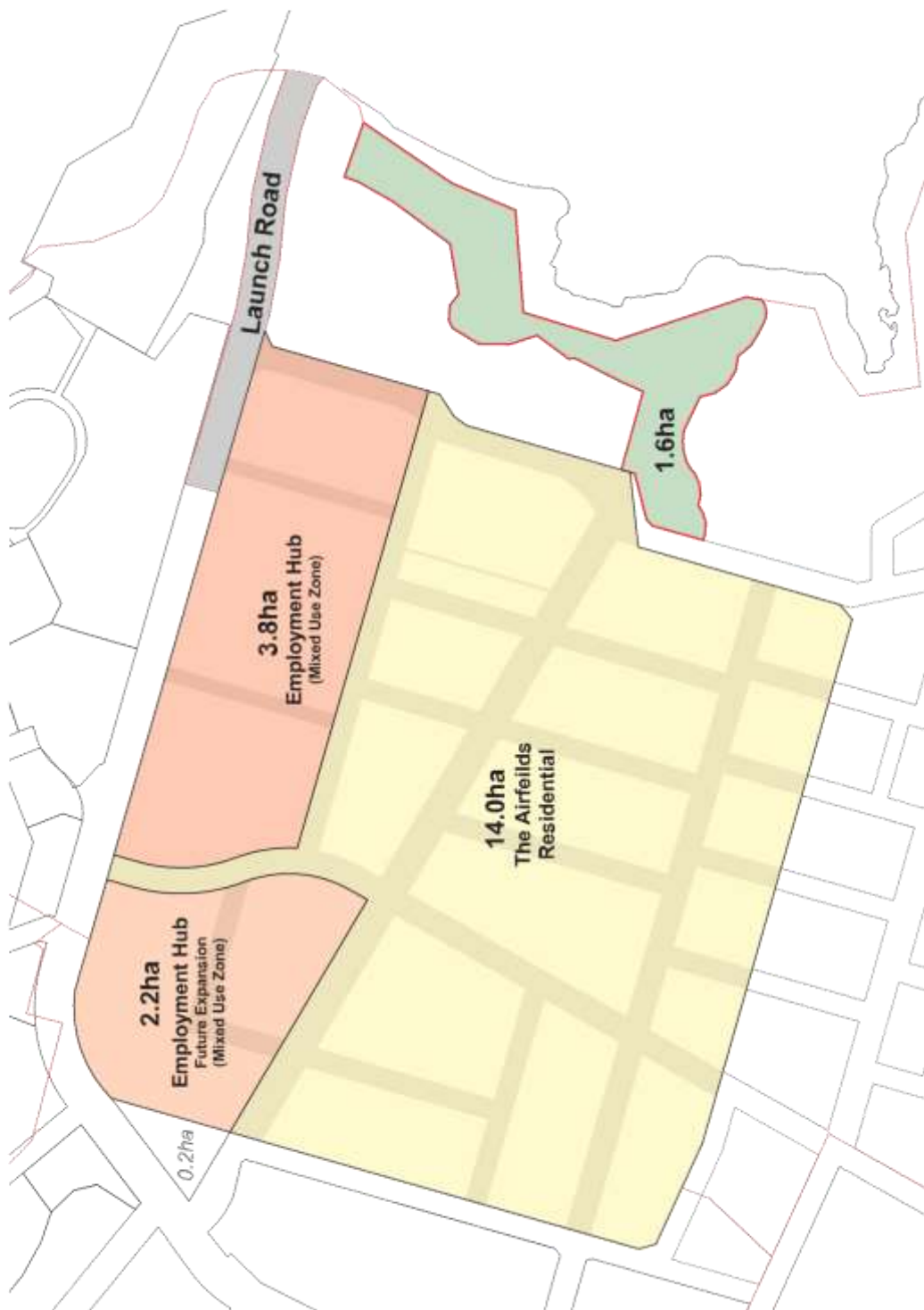
