Public Consultation to the Mangere Otahuhu Local Board

On behalf of our Marae Trustees and Whanau of Papatuanuku Kokiri Marae we would like to submit our expression of interest in the future plans for the property at 161R Robertson Road, Mangere.

The building and the property boundary joins parallel to our Marae. As stated in our letter dated the 17th June 2015 this Papakainga serviced the needs of our communities locally, regionally and in many circumstances internationally as a place for healing. We strongly believe that we as a whole community can reignite the breath of life in this building and its surroundings.

For those that are not familiar with our Marae, we are pan-tribal where we all come from different walks of life, not just Maori but those from Korea, India, the Pacific Islands and beyond our shores.

We are neutral to any political stance or political parties, however very powerful in regards to challenging the injustices of the world, both socially and environmentally. Currently we are overloaded with servicing the needs and aspirations of our community, from our new born babies through to the needs of our elderly, and very limited space to give it great justice from high-quality and welcoming public spaces, great facilities that are culturally welcoming through to our healthy green places and waterways.

Where we come together to shape local activities to ensure we address the things people care about in our community

This building would service the needs on the model that already exists, so we have walked the talk, we have built the dream for our community.

Under the Councils approach to the Treaty, its policies and how these plans are implemented **we to as Maori** also have an obligation to service the needs of our treaty partner.

We do this by ensuring that we openly share our way of life and how we look at the world, we ensure we strive for common grounds of nurturing our planet and all that gives life to it

On these grounds we submit our Expression of Interest.

I do have a few questions:

Has there been a feasibility report on the building to see if it is structurally viable.

What was the original plan for the building as it has been sitting dormant for such a long time, to the point that it is been broken into and been structurally ruined

My last point if I could leave this on the council table, along with the Boxing club, Railway Club, the community house and the soccer club we are all addressed as an inclusive model of Centre Park.

As a Marae Whanau we would like to seek clarity as to why are we the only tenants that mow our extensive lawns, trim the hedge that overlaps the public walk pathway and clean our own grounds at our own costs. We look forward to your responses to our "tono".

The Mangere Bridge and Ratepayers resolved at their July meeting--:

That NZTA be advised that we consider that a rail route from Onehunga to the Airport must be shown in conjunction with the plans to construct the East West Connection, and that the new footbridge to replace the old Mangere Bridge should be built beside it giving pedestrians the best route through the area.
