# **Annual Report to Local Board**

12th October 2015

# Background

Destination Great Barrier Island Inc. (DGBI) was established by the Local Board in August 2012 with budgeted funding of 25,000 per annum (inflation adjusted) for ten years.

The Mission of DGBI is "to grow the economy of the island through growth in tourism".

In August 2014 DGBI also took over the responsibility for the management of the GBI I-site under an agreement with ATEED. ATEED agreed to provide diminishing funding over a three-year period.

#### 1. Visitor information and services

#### 1.1 I-site

The key Initiative is the management of the I-site.

There is a longer term issue with respect to future funding of the I-site operation. The current DGBI budget (attached) shows that there will be a shortfall in income over expenditure in the 2017/18 FY. However, because there has been a build-up in funds DGBI could continue to operate at a similar level to the present for a few more years. (e.g hours of operation of the I-site).

#### Longer term funding

#### DGBI is attempting to increase the level of income through its activities by

- Increasing commissions through bookings
- sales of brochures
- sale of advertising on website
- financial support from DOC.

#### but is also considering

- development of commissionable packages
- sale of merchandise (e.g. t shirts)
- sale of water etc? (need fridge)





Each Monday Barney meets Bill at his work shop to learn how to weld, design and build motors and other mechanics etc.

Barney enjoys his time with Bill and they get along really well.

Barney was previously at Boarding school where he was bullied and suffered greatly, he couldn't manage schooling away from home so after a term and a half of homesickness and getting picked on we decided to bring him home.

Upon his return to Gt Barrier he suffered low self-esteem and behaviour issues stemming from his ADHD and treatment at Boarding school, we decided the best strategy was to get him busy and involved in community projects/schooling.

I went looking for teachers/tutors and heard about the great work Bill was doing with another boy Desmond.

Barney has thrived under Bill's mentoring and tuition, they just get on with learning and creating together. They do planning and design as well as learning to weld and fix motors/ bikes/ tools etc, they even helped Barney's nana make a garden sculpture which she will exhibit at the local art gallery!

Bill's class has been instrumental in Barney's success here on Barrier, he feels pride, achievement and for the first time in a long time is excited about going to tutoring/class.

Barney was going 4hours which was perfect but we were finding it a bit expensive and had to drop his art tutor and then Bill's time down to 3 hours. Bill is absolutely worth every cent so we were a bit gutted to cut Barn back, 4 hours is ideal!

I would love all the kids to have access to Bill's class, it's such a wonderful skill for a youth to learn going into adult life, especially one with academic struggles such as Barney. We are so grateful for the time Bill puts into our son and would love to gain funding to help keep him accessible to our son and other youth on GBI.

Bill has our highest recommendation for funding; in his class our son is safe, happy, motivated, learning and thinking about his future!
