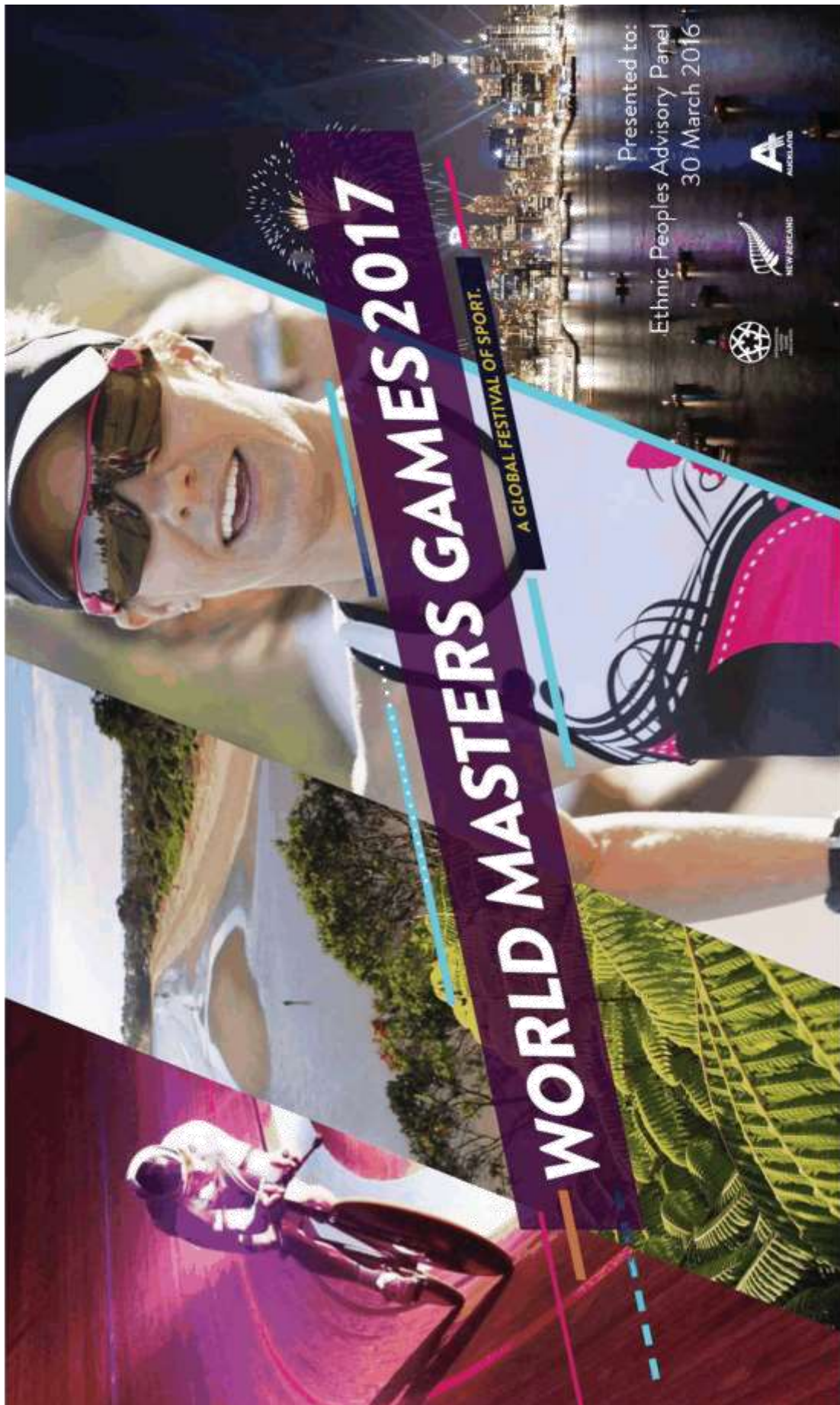

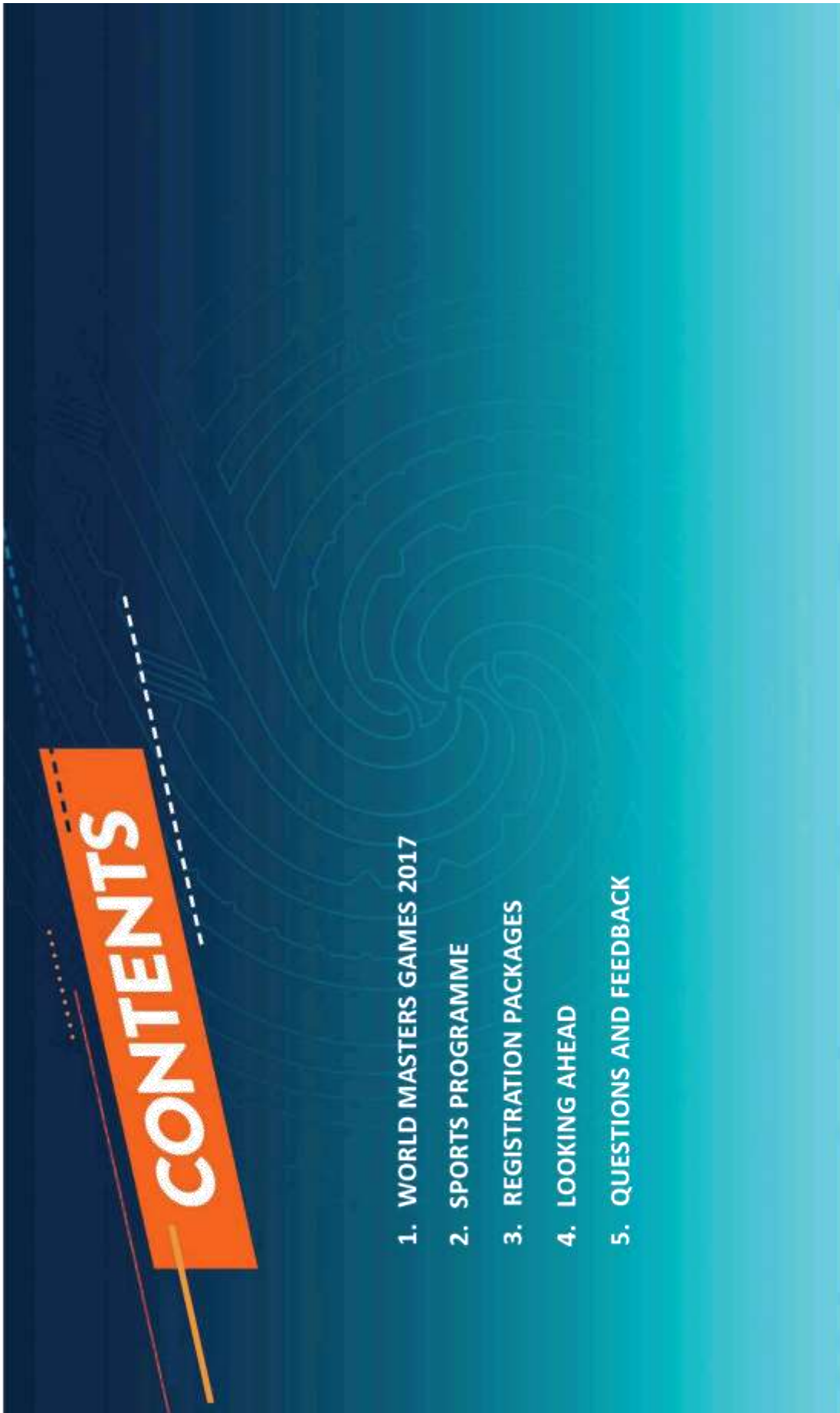

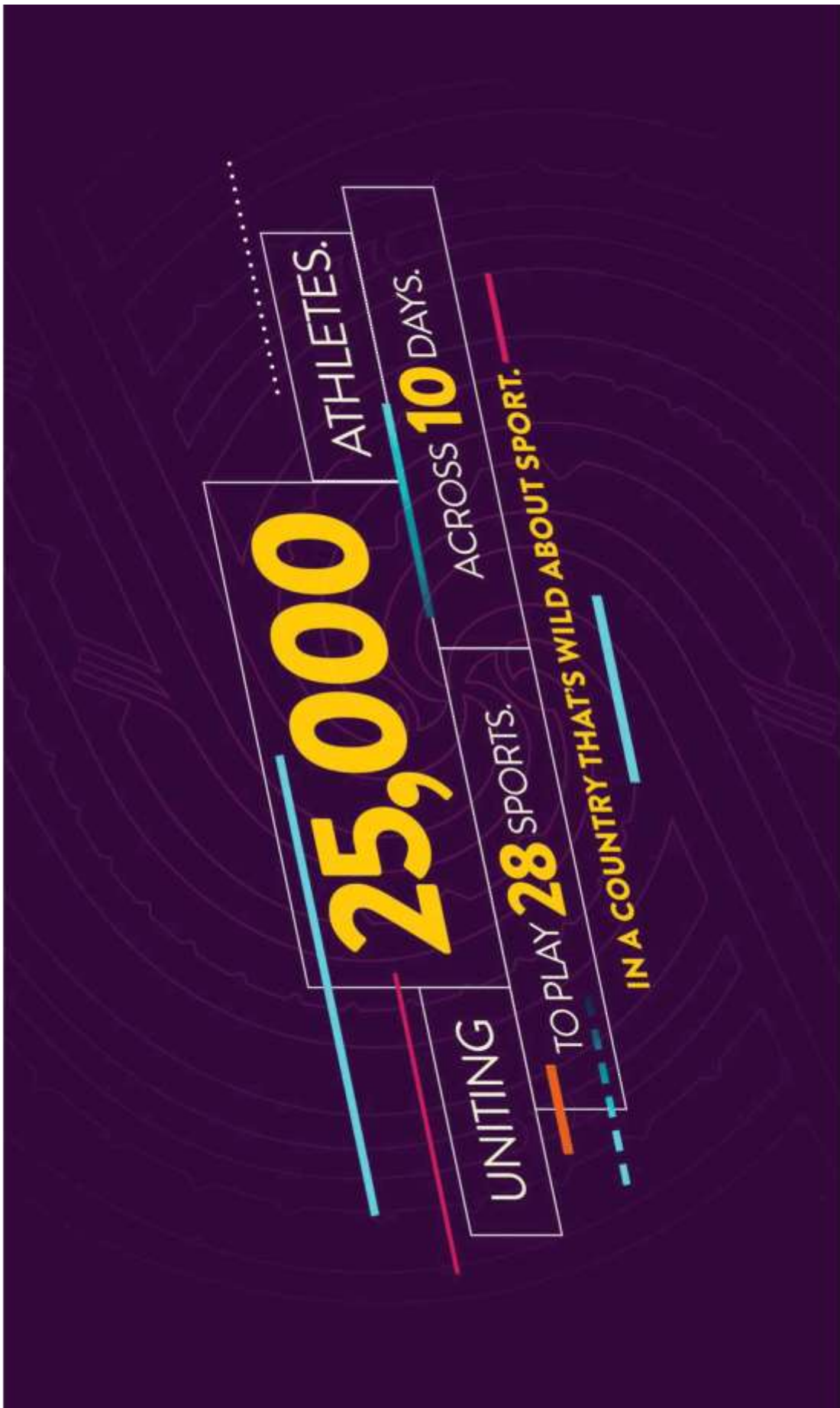

## THE GAMES HEADLINES

- **LARGEST MULTISPORT EVENT IN THE WORLD**
  - 28 sports, 45 disciplines across 45+ competition venues
- **25,000 ATHLETES**
  - Over double the number of athletes when compared to the summer Olympics
  - Ranging from elite through to social
- **100 COUNTRIES REPRESENTED**
  - Although athletes compete as individuals, national pride is clearly evident
  - More than half the athletes will come from offshore
- **NO QUALIFYING CRITERIA OTHER THAN AGE**
  - Minimum age is as low as 25 in some sports, up to 35 in others
  - Highest representation falls in the 40 – 49 age bracket
- **PRIMARY MOTIVATIONS OF COMPETITORS:**
  - a lifelong passion for sport
  - enjoyment of social activity around sport
  - desire for a travel and cultural experience


