Hi Jim

Thanks for taking the time to talk to me on Friday afternoon. I'm sorry I wasn't able to send through the email over the weekend as promised, I had some family matters that took precedence. Please accept my apologies in relation to this.

I'm sending you this email directly in the hopes that we can find a way forward where both parties are comfortable with the licence issuing.

From my understanding, there are several issues that were of concern to you:

1. Closing time of the store - you requested 10pm - currently they have until 11pm
2. The imposition of a condition stating no sales of single bottles or cans of RTD's beer or cider under 500ml
3. Signage needs to comply with the bylaws
4. 50% clear visibility through the front windows into the store

Points 3 & 4 have been already been completed which leaves us with points 1 and 2 to resolve.

Single sales

Currently, the store does not sell single bottles of RTDs, beer or cider under 500ml. There is no intention to start now. However, it is our preference not to have this imposed as a condition of licence: there can be the very rare instance of when a package is damaged and a single bottle broken. This then leaves 3 or 5 bottles to sell. My client is happy to give an undertaking to you that he will not actively promote any single sales of these products, and will not deliberately break open packages for their sale.

Hours of Trading

The store generally closes before 10pm Sunday to Thursday, and around 11pm on a Friday and Saturday night. At certain times of the year the store is busier later in the evening and it may choose to stay open until 11pm. These are generally on long weekends, or prior to Easter and the lead up to Christmas. The licensee has already stated that he is happy with the hours of trade as they are and will give an undertaking to you that he will not change the manner in which he operates and that the regular closing time will remain at 10pm.

I trust that you find this acceptable and look forward to hearing from you following discussions with Yvonne.
