It is a Public Recreation reserve that the public has a right to.

Castaways is a prime example of public land now “out of reach” to the general public .... Not many can afford to go there.

Castaways was originally supposed to be a health and education centre to benefit the peoples of Waiuku, and now it is an exclusive playground for the rich.

How it became so was challenged some years ago however the records seem to have been “misplaced”.

Karioitahi is a huge public asset one of a kind , and it is councils responsibility to ensure that it remains so and does NOT follow in Castaways footsteps.
