Helensville Art Centre	Sally Lush from Helensville Art Centre	Ms Lush outlined the highlights and challenges of the art centre since moving in to new premises in the Helensville War Memorial Hall. The matters raised have been forwarded to the Property Department and officers will updating the local board at a workshop.
Proposal for a bike and skatepark at Warkworth Showgrounds	Nicola Jones, and Brett Illingworth of Mahurangi Sport and Recreation Collective	Mr Jones outlined a proposal for a bike track and skatepark at the Warkworth Showgrounds. The information has been forwarded to the Parks Advisor for the Rodney Local Board and Ms Jones has been advised to apply for a contestable community grant through the Rodney Local Board Community Grants.
Kumeu Art Centre	Christine Rose and Sarah Ellis-Kirifi from Kumeu Art Centre	Ms Rose outlined a proposal to extend the Kumeu Art Centre. The presentation has been forwarded to the Arts Advisor and the local board are expecting a report on a plan for expansion of the art centre at a future business meeting.
Pasifika Festival – Mahu Vision Trust	Neville Johnson from Mahu Vision Trust	Mr Johnson outlined the proposal for the Pasifika Festival which has been held for several years in a row in the Warkworth area and is gaining popularity. Mr Johnson sought local board support for the proposal and said that he would be applying for a grant for the event.

The local board previously granted funding for this project which has since been modified. Mr Dinniss sought support from the local board to give an extension of time for the grant.
