1. **Apologies:** There was an apology from Member Steele.
2. **Preliminary road upgrade proposals associated with Huapai SHA:** Auckland Transport representatives; Dai Bindoff (Senior Communication and Consultation Advisor), Emad Abdulmalek (Senior Engineer – Investigation and Design) and Ellen Barrett (Elected Member Relationship Manager) in attendance for this item. Mr Bindoff outlined the preliminary proposal for road upgrades associated with the SHA in Huapai and sought feedback from the initial proposals before formal consultation with the public is held in August.
3. **Old Woodcocks Road Dust Suppression Trials:** Auckland Transport representatives, Ellen Barrett (Elected Member Relationship Manager), Nahri Salim (Communications Advisor) and Graham Bell (Design Delivery Leader - North) in attendance for this item. Also in attendance, from Hutchinson Consultants, Ian Hutchinson and Neil Douglas. Old Woodcocks Road has been identified as the road for dust suppressant trials. The trial will investigate means of mitigating dust nuisance with a variety of pavement treatments. The trial is expected to begin in September and there will be signage at either end of the road in addition to specific signage regarding the treatment sections. Auckland Transport will collate data which will include performance, dust fall-out results etc. The potential to share the results of the trial with other councils was raised. Auckland Transport would seek feedback from local residents and schools in the area within 3 months of the beginning of the trial. The trial could potentially go for 5 years but this would depend on the results collected.

4. **Proposal for an arts/artisan trail in Rodney:** ATEED representatives; John Norman (Strategic Planner, Local Economic Development), Luo Lei (Local Economic Development Advisor), Neville Collett (Local Economic Development Business Advisor); Barbara Cade (Team Leader Event Facilitation North West), Xanthe Jujnovich (Arts and Culture Advisor) and Sue Dodds (Strategic Advisor) in attendance for this item. The officers in attendance outlined a proposal for an arts/artisan trail in North West Rodney and sought feedback from the local board members as to whether the idea had merit as being put forward as an option for the local economic development budget.
