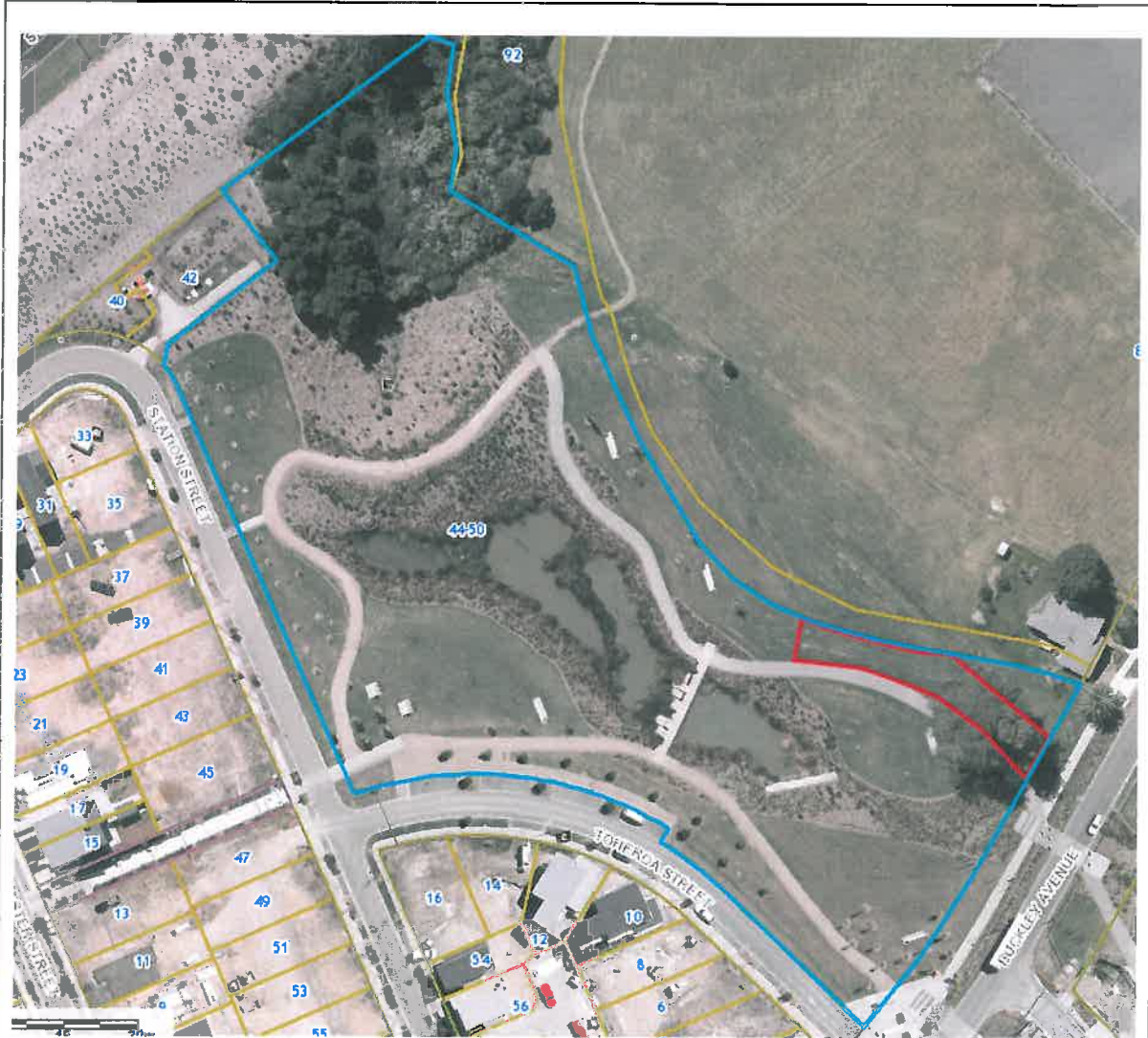
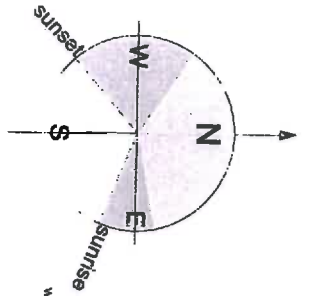

Licenced area for the community garden outlined in red – total garden area 114 square metres



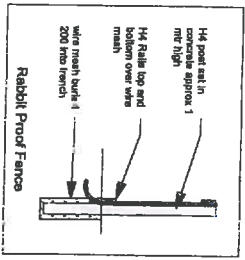


council required 1.5 mtr offset from existing foot path

rabbit proof fence around from waterford temp fence along western boundary to temp gate on road

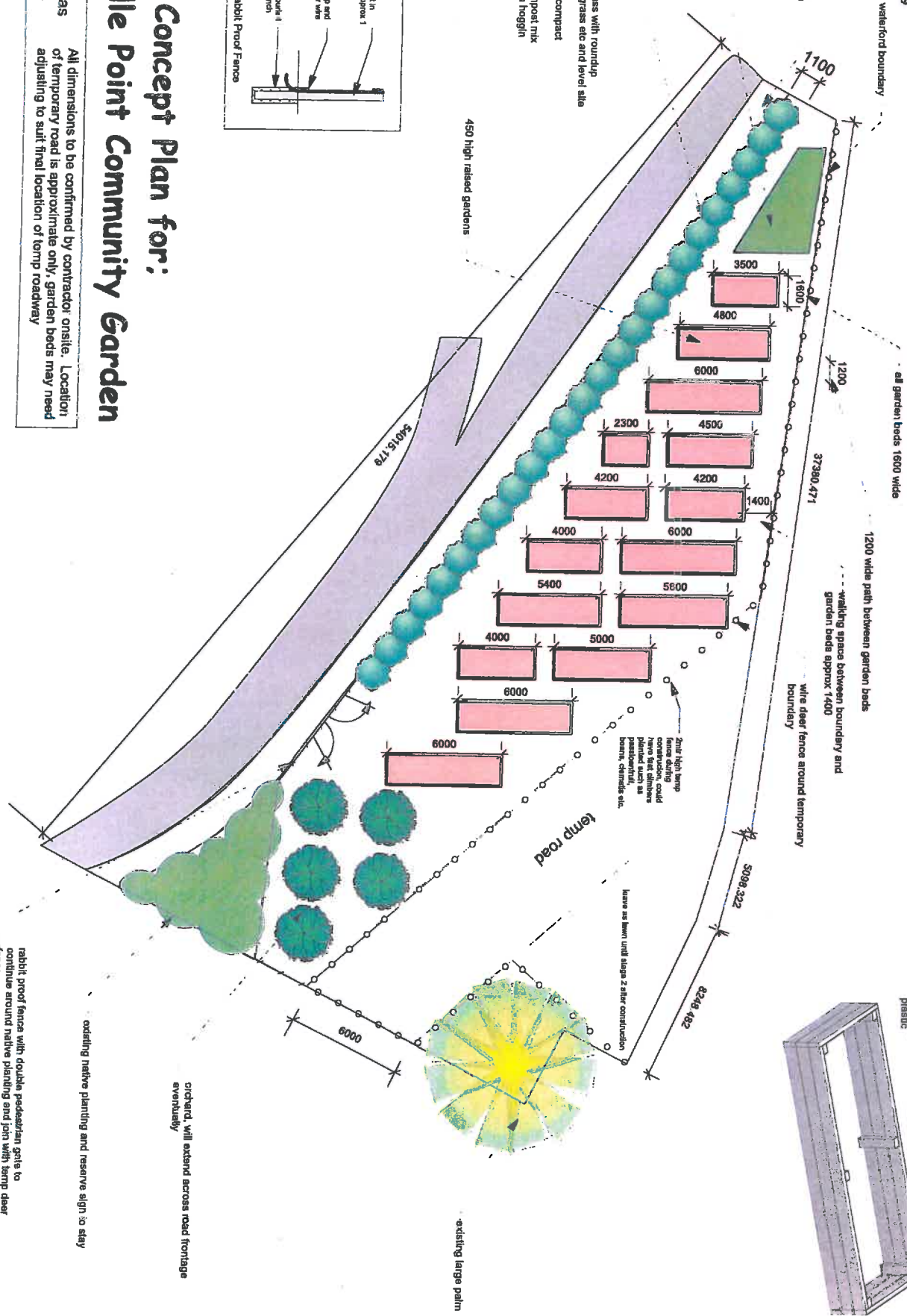
- Process:
1. Spray out all existing Kikuyu grass with roundup
 2. Remove top 150mm of top soil/grass etc and level site
 3. Place and pin slyx geotextile
 4. Cover with 150mm GAP20 and compact
 5. Build and position raised beds.
 6. Fill raised beds with top soil/compost mix
 7. Cover GAP 20 with 80 - 100 mm height
 8. Build perimeter rabbit fence
 9. Build perimeter rabbit fence
 10. Plant boundary planting



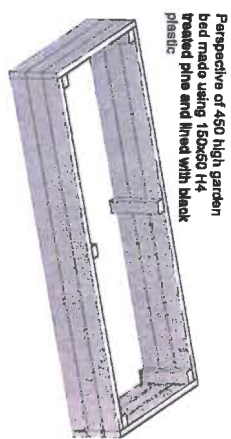
Concept Plan for: Hobsonville Point Community Garden
