

**DELEGATED DECISION OF THE
MAUNGAKIEKIE-TĀMAKI LOCAL BOARD**

SUBJECT

To seek approval to allocate \$30,000 in the Sports and Recreation participation project LDI budget to deliver a Bikes in Schools initiative at Pt England School.

AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE DELEGATED DECISION PROCESS

At the Maungakiekie-Tāmaki Local Board Business Meeting held on 16 June 2016 the board agreed the following delegated decision under resolution *MT/2016/102* to:

- c) *delegates to the parks, sport and recreation portfolio holder to approve any minor changes or amendments to the parks, sport and recreation work programme.*

BACKGROUND

The 2016/2017 Maungakiekie-Tāmaki Local Board Agreement identifies an LDI budget of increasing participation in sport and recreation.

Staff have worked with the Bike On New Zealand Charitable Trust to progress options to deliver bikes in schools initiatives within the Tamaki subdivision of the local board area.

Pt England School has been identified as the preferred option due to its large roll and proximity to current and planned on-road and off-road cycle network infrastructure.

Pt England School is decile 1, state full primary school (years 1 - 8) with a registered roll of 611 students (as at 1 July 2015).

Funding of \$30,000 would be tagged to:

- Construction costs for either a riding, pump or skills track located within the school ground.

Key performance indicators are likely to include:

- Construction of the track prior to 30 June 2017
- 90% of students completing cycle skills training
- 90% of teachers complete a "train the trainer" cycle skills course
- 90% of students demonstrate competence on bikes three months after completing cycle skills training
- School fundraise for the cost of a fleet of bikes, helmets and storage container.

RECOMMENDATIONS

As per resolution MT/2016/102 the Maungakiekie-Tāmaki Local Board through delegation to the Chairperson SD Randall and the Parks, Sport and Recreation Portfolio Holder JB Clark approve the allocation of \$30,000 to deliver the 2016/2017 participation project in Pt England School


