Ongoing transport issues include traffic management during the temporary closure of southbound State Highway onramp at Dominion Road, work on speed feedback indicator on Farrelly Avenue, parking restrictions on Louvain Avenue, Marco Polo Avenue, Freeland Avenue and Cape Horn Road, footpath repairs and rough order of costs for traffic calming on Gilletta Road and parking and pedestrian safety issues at the Roskill South roundabout.

A memorandum from Auckland Transport updates these issues and provides details on the 23 November official opening of Mt. Roskill Safe Routes, the 10 December Safe Routes Family Fun Day, extension of bus lane hours, bus lane coverage on Mt. Eden Road, Dominion Road and May Road ,and the T3 lane on Pah and Manukau Road.

The memorandum also covers progress on the Ernie Pinches to Wesley Community Centre project, Fearon Park Pathway, Richardson Road and Noton Road car parks and Keith Hay park lighting (southern section) all of which involve contributions from the Puketapapa Local Board Transport Capital Fund.

Other topics cover the City Rail Link, Light Rail Update, Karangahape Road makeover, bus patronage on Dominion and Mt. Eden Roads bus services in South Auckland and 99 cent weekend child bus fares. A full Transport Report will be provided to the December Board Business meeting.
