Bike thefts in Devonport . I had been contact by members of the public as there have been many bike thefts in the Devonport area . I have spoken with Community Constable Jasmine Blundle , who informed me that this problem has been ongoing for the last year , however it has escalated over recent months . Many of these locked bikes were stolen from the Library , Wharf and outside the Gym as well as from private property. Identifying these criminals was difficult with the lack of CCTV in Devonport. One of the bikes stolen recently had a value of \$ 5000.00 and this is not unusual.

Jasmine also said that there had been a number of arsons attempts and with the lack of CCTV it has been difficult to apprehend the suspects.

There is also a call for CCTV at the Takapuna Bus Station where drugs are regularly sold. Many of the people who “ hanging out “ there are making it uncomfortable for commuters with threatening behaviour.

There have been incidents where bus drivers have been reluctant to let customers off because of the people hanging around.

We have to make the Devonport Takapuna ward as safe as possible.
