- Guide council and CCO strategies
- **Some are statutory**

- Waste Management and Minimisation Plan
 - Sports and Recreation Strategic Action Plan
 - Regional Land Transport Plan

- Asset Management Plans
- Targets
- Implement Auckland Plan policies and strategies
