I am the Ministry of Education School Property Advisor for the Okiwi School. The school and the Ministry are currently finalising the 10 Year Property Plan for the school and one of the two projects proposed involves the upgrade of the Learning Environment of Block 1 and Block 8 (the Whare Tuakana and the Whare Teina respectively). I can confirm that the Ministry of Education supports the upgrade of school property to support flexible and innovative learning environments and although some details will be finalised in the next few days – supports this project in principle .

The school receives Capital Funding form Ministry of Education on a 5 yearly basis . I do note that the extent of funding provided means that the Project will not be completely funded from this source and will require some support from a Community Funding Agency.
