8.1 Deputation - Feed the Need

Resolution number OP/2016/91

MOVED by Member MA Gush, seconded by Member LT Fuli:

That the Ōtara-Papatoetoe Local Board:

- a) thank Laurie Wharemate-Keung, Jacinda Adern, Jenny Salesa and Sully Paea for their attendance and presentation.
- b) request a report from Community Empowerment Unit to identify a suitable location for Feed the Need to base its food preparation activities, with consideration of the suitability of existing facilities, including Kolmar and Rongomai multi-sport facilities and Te Puke o Tara community centre.
- c) request a report from Community Facilities on the future of the former Crosspower building on Sandbrook Reserve, including the option of demolition.
