I contributed to the Political Reference Group commenting on the **Government Policy Statement On Land Transport**.

The construction of the **Ernie Pinches to Wesley Community Centre Cycleway** has generated concerns requiring meetings with the principal of Wesley Intermediate School and an affected Sandringham Road resident. These stemmed in part from gaps in the consultation process. However those involved do acknowledge that the cycleway will be an asset to the community.

May Road Primary School is developing a training path as part of the **Bikes In Schools** programme.

The announcement that the NZ Transport Agency and Auckland Transport have agreed that **light rail** to Auckland Airport via Dominion Road is approved is a breakthrough for future passenger transport in Puketapapa. However, the 30 year time scale is far too slow and will undoubtedly be reviewed.
