




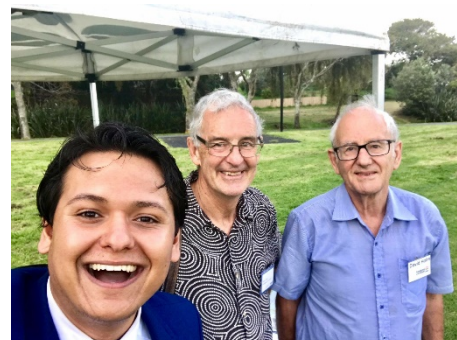

Other issues/challenges

The works on the damaged section of the Kallu Crescent Footpath (Ref: CAS425917) is still pending, as of 4th April due to the heavy rain experienced by Auckland on between 3rd April-5th April. However, Council Officers have conducted a site visit and are aware of the unusable section of the footpath. I have requested Officers to report any progress that is made to me directly, another follow up would be done 10th April. But due to the weather forecast from 12th April onwards, and the occurrence of Easter break, it is highly unlikely that repairs or that any progress would be made on the damaged section until after the Easter break.

I will be reporting any progress directly to the Heritage and Infrastructure Cluster, and in my next report.

Moreover, in the reporting period, based on my work programme I have also requested the statistics for Crime rate in Puketapapa and wider Auckland area. In particular, from the last three years, in order to identify any trends locally, as well as how Puketapapa trends with other Local Board areas and in contrast to Auckland as a region. This is still pending, and I have been advised by staff that these may not be available within the Auckland Council organization and may require the Board to commission a project in order to gain those statistics simplified as per our Local Board Area. Another alternative would be for me to personally carry out such a project or use other mediums to gain the required data.

I will be working more on this with the Community Cluster, as the data that I have requested would prove invaluable for the Board to gain a better understanding of Community Safety in Puketapapa area, and base any decisions upon.
