LB Project	373 New North Road	<p>Auckland Transport on behalf of the Albert – Eden Local Board is proposing to establish a pedestrian island refuge and associated no stopping at all times markings (NSAAT) adjacent to 373 New North Road.</p> <p>After an investigation Auckland Transport is proposing to establish a pedestrian island refuge located within the existing flush median, two new pram crossings and to install No Stopping At All Times marking (NSAAT) on the southside of New North Road. This will provide a safe crossing point for pedestrians. Consultation plan for details of the proposal was provided</p>	5 May 2017	
Resource Consent	223 Greenlane West Rd	<p>Resource consent has been granted for the development of residential units at the Auckland Trotting Club. As part of the development it is proposed to upgrade the intersection and the control near 373 Greenlane West Road. In addition the new layout will improve accessibility for cyclists and pedestrians moving through the area.</p>	21 April 2017	
Traffic Operations	Herdman Street	<p>Following feedback received from the initial consultation for restrictions either side of the crossing on Herdman Street. AT has investigated installing an additional 36m of NSAAT markings on the north side of the T-intersection; see revised drawings provided. This will improve the visibility for those crossing by the playground/school and also road users travelling south-east.</p>	9 May 2017
