Initiative	Description	Advocating to
Funding for <b>Orewa Beach Esplanade Enhancement Plan</b>	Request funding to address coastal asset degradation, including implementation of the Orewa Beach Esplanade Enhancement Plan (OBEEP), in particular urgent works in zones 3, 3A and 4, Kohu Street to Marine View, Orewa.	Governing body
Deliver <b>Penlink</b> earlier	Request that Penlink is delivered earlier than 2025-2035 to alleviate development issues and ease significant congestion at pinch points affecting residents and businesses on both the Whangaparaoa Peninsula and at Silverdale. This project will also provide a ‘lifeline’ route when emergency situations cause traffic disruption or road closures along Whangaparaoa Road. Residents raise ongoing concerns about feeling disconnected due to inadequate access for education, employment and business and Penlink would address many of these significant matters.	Governing body
Realignment of the <b>East Coast/Lonely Track/Glenvar Roads intersection</b>	Request that the realignment of the East Coast/Lonely Track/Glenvar Roads intersection is undertaken at the same time as building Glenvar Ridge Road, to address safety concerns. This is one of the most dangerous intersections in the Auckland region and will be exacerbated by the increased traffic flows due to Long Bay’s extensive growth in new housing and commercial development.	Governing body
