

**Attachment B:** Assessment of name against *Auckland Council Road Naming Guidelines (April 2015)*

<b>Principle 1: Road Extents and Road Types will be clearly defined</b>	
Extent of the road is well-defined	Complies
All road names must include a road type	Complies
Road type accurately reflects the type or roadway being named	Complies
<b>Principle 2: Road names will promote public safety and service delivery</b>	
Name does not risk public and operational safety for emergency responses	Complies
All road name proposals must ensure that operations will not be adversely affected	Complies
<b>Principle 3: Road names will reflect the heritage of an area</b>	
Mana whenua, early settlers, war servicemen and women and other persons who have contributed to the heritage of an area, local history themes, flora, fauna etc. are examples of generally suitable types of road names	Complies
Collaboration between mana whenua, local interest groups, developers/ individuals	Complies
The names of people who are still alive should be avoided as community attitudes and opinions can change over time	Complies
Applicants must make every effort to gain consent from family members of the person being commemorated	N/A
<b>Principle 4: The use of Maori road names is actively encouraged</b>	
Actively encouraging the use of Maori road names	Complies
<b>Road Naming Criteria</b>	
Name only uses characters from a standard alphabet	Complies
Consultation with mana whenua where the location of a proposed road has been identified as of significance to mana whenua	Complies
Easily pronounced, spelt and written	Complies
Proposed name does not already exist within the Auckland Region	Complies
Proposed name is not spelt in a similar way to an existing road name	Complies
Proposed name does not sound like an existing road name	Complies
Road types do not distinguish different roads of the same or similar sounding names	Complies
Does not contain punctuations	Complies
Does not include abbreviations	Complies
Does not use "The" as the sole name element of a road name	Complies
Does not include a preposition	Complies
Does not include an apostrophe unless part of a person's name	Complies
Names starting with Mc or Mac shall not have a space included between the Mc or Mac and the rest of the road name	N/A
Has the same spelling as any name from which it is derived	Complies
Where numbers occur in a road name, they must be in full form	N/A
Proposed name does not include initials	Complies
Proposed name must not be considered offensive, racist, derogatory or demeaning	Complies
Proposed name must not be commercially based, unless they are no longer in use and reflect the heritage of an area	Complies
Road names shall not be misspelt	Complies
Road types shall not be used in the formation of a road name	Complies
The use of given or first names in conjunction with a surname is not normally acceptable	Complies
Proposed names shall not include qualifying terminology, a cardinal indicator or similar prefix	Complies
A directional word cannot be used to uniquely define a road extremities	Complies
Origin to destination names shall not be used so as to not confuse	Complies
Short roads that are named shall preferably have a short name	Complies
