Subject: **Update on the Auckland Plan Refresh**

This memo provides you with an update on the Auckland Plan refresh.

An information report summarising all the feedback received from the first round of Planning Committee workshops was tabled at the meeting on 2 May 2017.

The discussion at the workshops focused on the development strategy, the five inter-related themes and high-level strategic concepts intended to address Auckland's biggest challenges and opportunities.

Early engagement with stakeholders including community groups on the refresh of the Auckland Plan is being undertaken from May through to the end of June 2017.

The purpose of this engagement is to seek feedback on the key challenges and opportunities for Auckland and to enable stakeholders and community groups to provide early input before a draft plan is prepared.

To support this engagement, we have developed a set of information sheets on each proposed theme of the refresh. This information reflects the input from the Planning Committee workshops.
