

Attachment A - Paul Walden - Latin American & Spain Film Festival

In accordance with Standing Order 3.11.1, the following Notice of Motion has been received from Board Chairman Paul Walden for inclusion on the agenda for the Waiheke Local Board meeting being held on 22 June 2017:

Recommendation

That the Waiheke Local Board:

- a) grant \$3,210 to the Artworks Theatre from the board's Community Response (Locally Driven Initiatives) budget to coordinate the Latin American and Spain Film Festival opening event.
- b) grant \$900 to the Artworks Cinema from the board's Community Response (Locally Driven Initiatives) budget for projection and staff costs for the Latin American and Spain Film Festival.

Background

The Embassy of the Argentine Republic in New Zealand is proposing a Latin American and Spain Film Festival on Waiheke between September and December 2017. The board has been approached for support to promote the festival and contribute towards operating costs.

It is proposed that 11 movies be shown over two weeks at the Artworks Cinema with an opening event at the Artworks Theatre. The board's support is being sought to contribute to cinema and theatre costs to enable free admission to these events.

The Artworks Theatre and Artworks Cinema have estimated cost to deliver as follows:

Artworks costs:

Theatre hire, cleaning, security, advertising, posters	\$760
Band / performance costs	\$2,000
Artworks Theatre coordination \$30/hour x 15 hours	\$450

Cinema costs:


Cinema projection and staff costs	<u>\$900</u>
