### Registration

Registration will open in April 2017. There will also be options to sign-up to dip into other conferences taking part in Queenstown Research Week at the same time.

- Early bird registration (until 31 May) NZ\$600 (incl. GST)
- Full registration (after 31 May and until 20 August) NZ\$660 (incl. GST)
- Late registration (after 20 August) NZ\$720 (incl. GST)
- Delegate 1-day registration NZ\$330 (incl. GST)
- Student registration NZ\$440 (incl. GST)

### Student Registrations

A student is defined as a holder of a student identification card from a recognised tertiary or secondary educational institution or international student card. Students must be studying full time to qualify for the discounted rate.

### Payment Options

Payment **MUST** be received by 31 May 2017 to be eligible for the Early Bird Rates. Any unpaid registrations as at 1 June will automatically convert to the full registration rate. All registration fees must be made in full prior to the start of the conference, any unpaid registrations will automatically be cancelled.

### Accommodation

Rydges Hotel is the conference hotel, and discounted accommodation can be booked through the registration website in May. Alternative accommodation options nearby are provided below.

## Social functions

Back by popular demand, the conference ice-breaker will be a scenic cruise on Lake Wakatipu from Queenstown on board the iconic steamship TSS Earnslaw, which will disembark at Walter Peak High Country Farm for a BBQ dinner.

The conference dinner, at the end of the conference, will be held at the nearby Crowne Plaza Hotel.

#### *Tips for Overseas Travelers*

**Important!** If you are not a resident of Australia or New Zealand, you may need to get a Visitor's Permit. Certain nationals need to have their passport endorsed with a Visitor's Visa before departure. This process may take up to one month. Delegates should visit the New Zealand Immigration Service pages for more information.

The New Zealand currency is cents (c) and dollars (\$), with 100 cents equal to one dollar. Coins are in the denominations of 10c, 20c, 50c, \$1, and \$2. There are \$5, \$10, \$20, \$50, and \$100 notes available. One New Zealand dollar is worth approximately 75 US cents.

There are automatic teller machines in the airport and throughout most cities, should you wish to withdraw cash on your credit or debit cards.
