Pigeons	Education and advice.	Education and advice. Staff can provide education and advice on managing nuisance impacts.	Continue current management approach.
The issue of weeds on council land (and the need to control them more effectively if the public are asked to control their own weeds)	Enforcement of selected widespread pest plants in response to complaints.	Site-led programme for parks with significant ecological areas to manage a suite of up to 30 pest plants to an extent that protects the values of the parkland.	Council to lead by example on own land. Site-focused approach will enable more intensive management of pest plants to better protect priority ecosystems and threatened species.
Rabbits	Providing information, advice and referral services to landowners who wish to control rabbits on their land. Support for community pest control initiatives.	Current approach, plus addition of good neighbor rule requiring landowner control on complaints basis to reduce impacts on neighboring properties.	To prevent unreasonable impacts on neighboring properties.
