Figure 1 – Land supply for dwellings for Special Housing Areas and all of Auckland Housing Accord targets

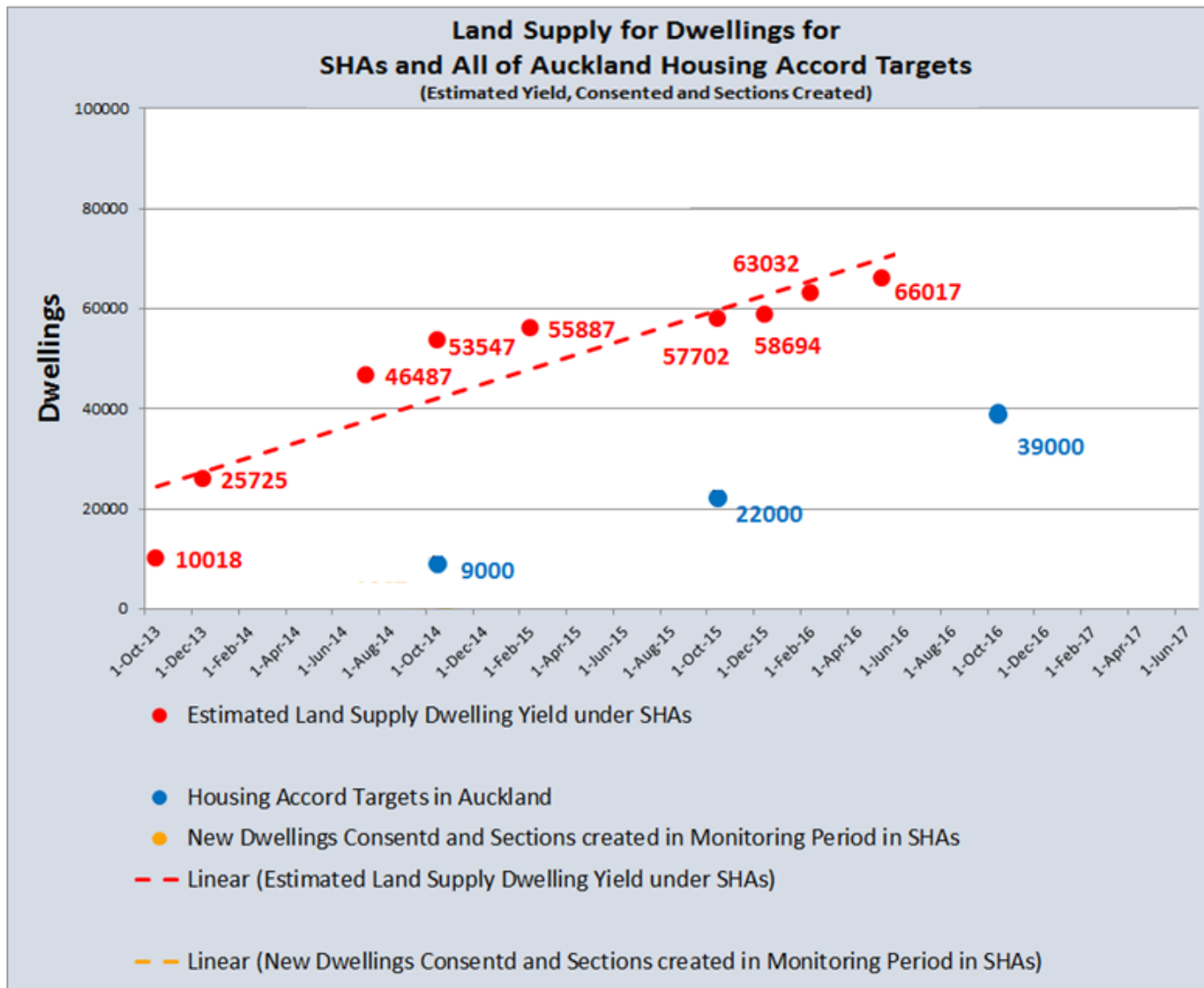
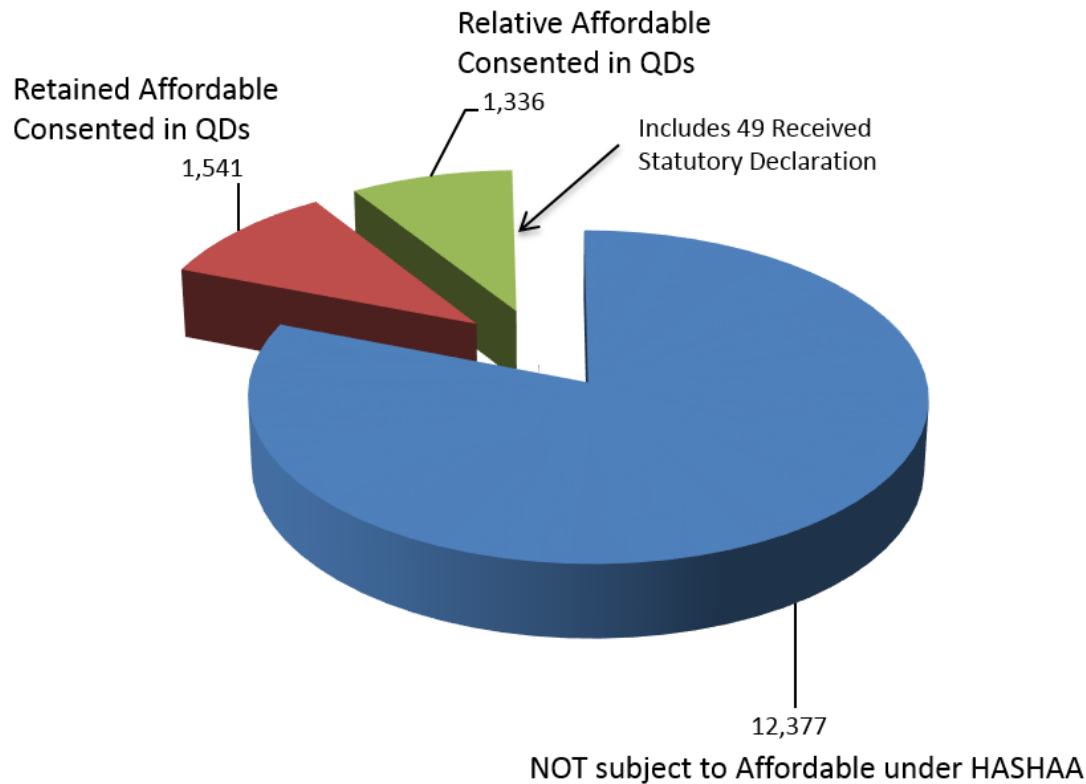


Figure 2 – Number of affordable dwellings from consented yield

### Points of Interest

- Total QDs resource consents under HASHAA for sections and dwellings Retained and Relative Affordable is (19.3%)
- Total Relative Affordable resource consents under HASHAA for sections and dwellings is (10.3%)
- Early days, whilst the development pipeline is in place only 49 (4%) of the required number of statutory declarations have been received in the first 3 years
