The Transport portfolio team have been working toward allocating the transport fund to the projects that were asked for by community members in the local board plan feedback. We also hope to work toward a plastic bag free area as this would be great for our community.

It was also very exciting to see the new Rainbow Path finished at the Northern end of Unitec, and I look forward to working on connecting the Alford bridge to Waterview in a safer way for people.
