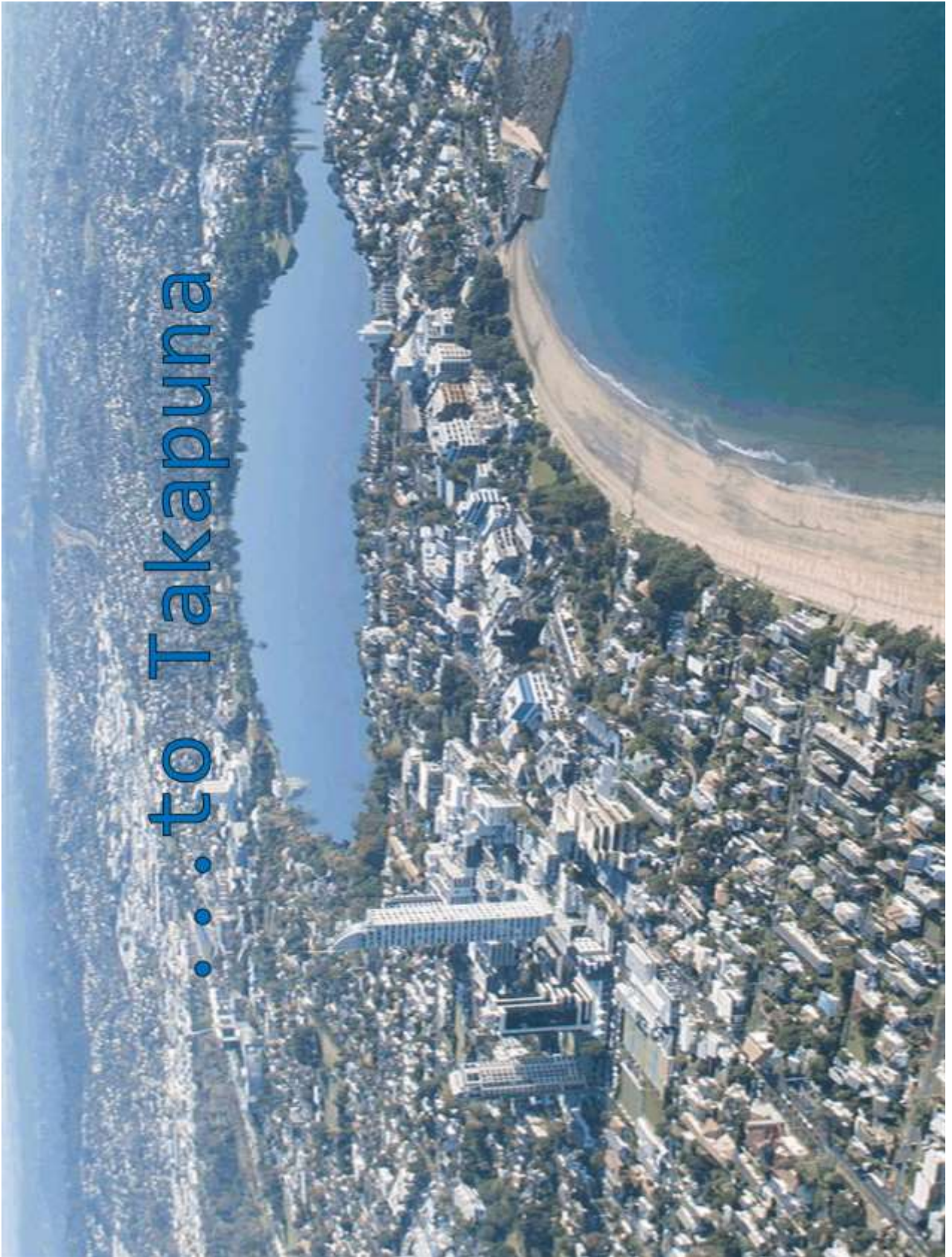

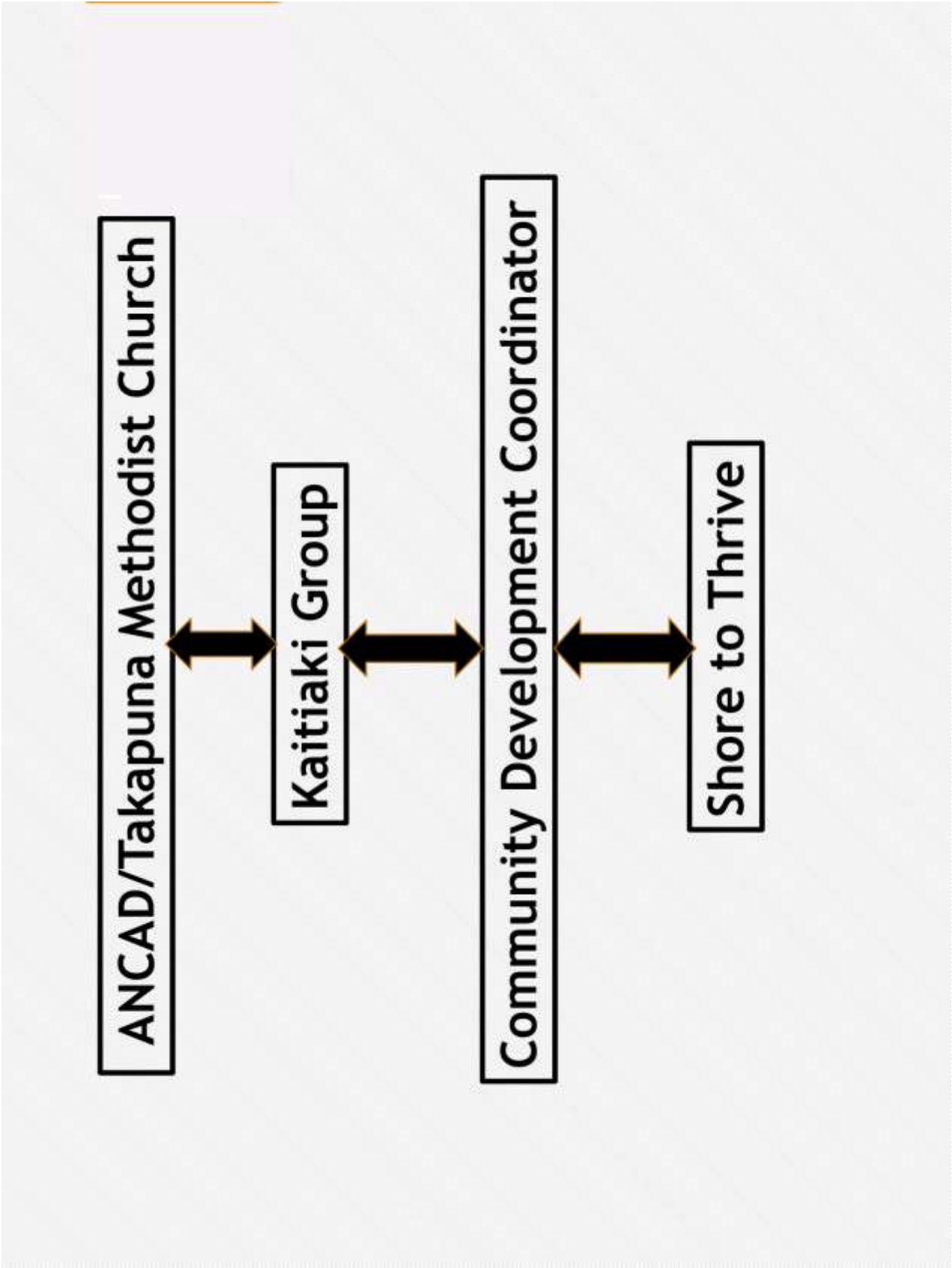

### Purpose

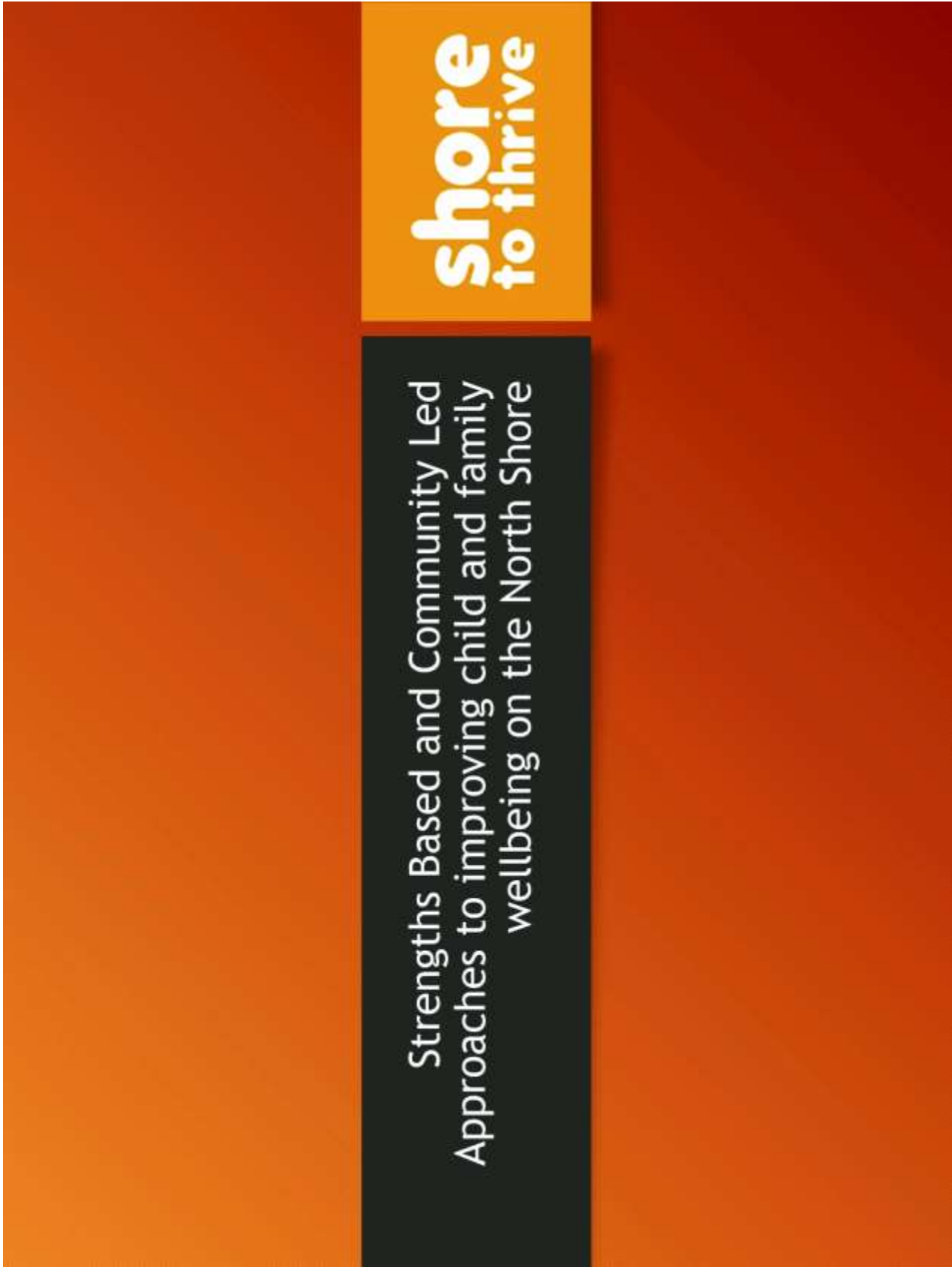
To develop and apply community-based and community led approaches to reducing child poverty and child abuse in the Devonport-Takapuna Local area.

A community development approach will build on local knowledge, experience and networks and draw on the findings of an international document review commissioned by ANCAD and carried out by Denise Bijoux of Catalyse in May 2015.



Working together across sectors and boundaries and committing to a long term approach is essential to tackle complex community issues such as reducing child poverty and child abuse which have multiple root causes.

This is a multi-faceted approach based on the development of trust, relationships and networks that can help to mobilise communities and existing assets and find common purpose to achieve the goal.
