Auckland Council Local Alcohol Policy Project - Feedback on decision from Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority

The Manurewa Local Board considered the report entitled "Auckland Council Local Alcohol Policy Project – Feedback on decision from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority" At this meeting it was resolved to delegate authority to the Chairperson, Angela Dalton and Deputy Chairperson, Rangi McLean, to prepare the Manurewa Local Board feedback on the Auckland Council Local Alcohol Policy Project noting the 1 September 2017 deadline

Feedback

The Manurewa Local Board is committed to reducing the negative impact that alcohol has on this community and on our whanau. The board is supportive of a consistent region-wide approach to policy and planning to reduce alcohol-related harm and provides the following feedback as part of the Auckland council review.

The Manurewa Local Board:

a) Does not support the deletion of the element;

- **Clause 4.3.1 - Off-Licence Maximum Trading Hours**

Maximum trading hours for off-licence premises. This is the proposed 9.00am restriction on opening and the 9.00pm restriction on closing

b) Does not support the deletion of the element, however understand that if the said element is beyond the legal authority of the Act it may be found unreasonable;

- **Clauses 4.3.2 and 4.3.3 - Remote Sellers**

Restrictions for the hours of delivery of alcohol for remote sellers;

c) Does not support the deletion of the element;

- **Clauses 4.2.2 and 4.2.3 - Renewals of Off-Licences Requiring a Local Impacts Report**

A requirement for the District Licensing Committee and the Authority to have regard to a Local Impacts Report when an off-licence is renewed for certain premises

d) Does not support the deletion of the element;

- **Clause 4.5.1(c) – Discretionary Condition for Off-Licences – Single Sales**

Consideration of a discretionary condition for off-licences regarding single sales being included for certain premises

e) Does not support the deletion of the element;

- **Clause 4.5.1(d) – Discretionary Condition for Off-Licences Afternoon Closing –**

Consideration of a discretionary condition for off-licences to be closed in the afternoon if located near education facilities

f) Seeks to be kept informed of progress and receive advice from staff of any changes and the potential impact on Manurewa
