Ms Jones will report back to the local board after investigating legal steps for closure of the path.

She presented a variety of options for the local board's information and consideration. The local Lions Club have expressed an interest in working with the local board on the Rautawhiri Park perimeter path by installing a number of fitness stations. The possibility of obtaining Growth Funding (available region wide) for both projects was discussed. Officers will report back on both projects with recommendations on options and as to how any funding shortfall can be addressed.</p>
