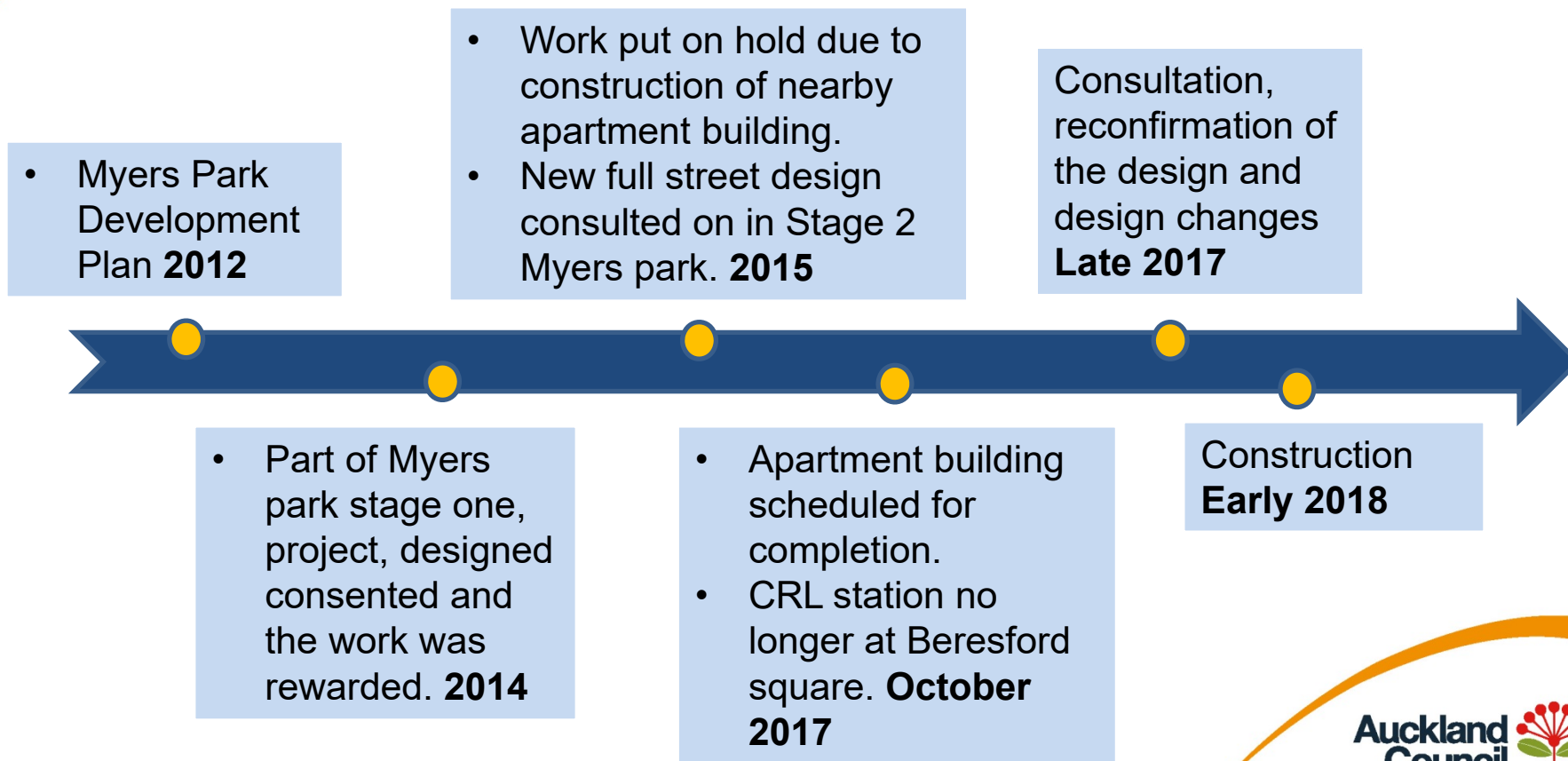

Access and entrances

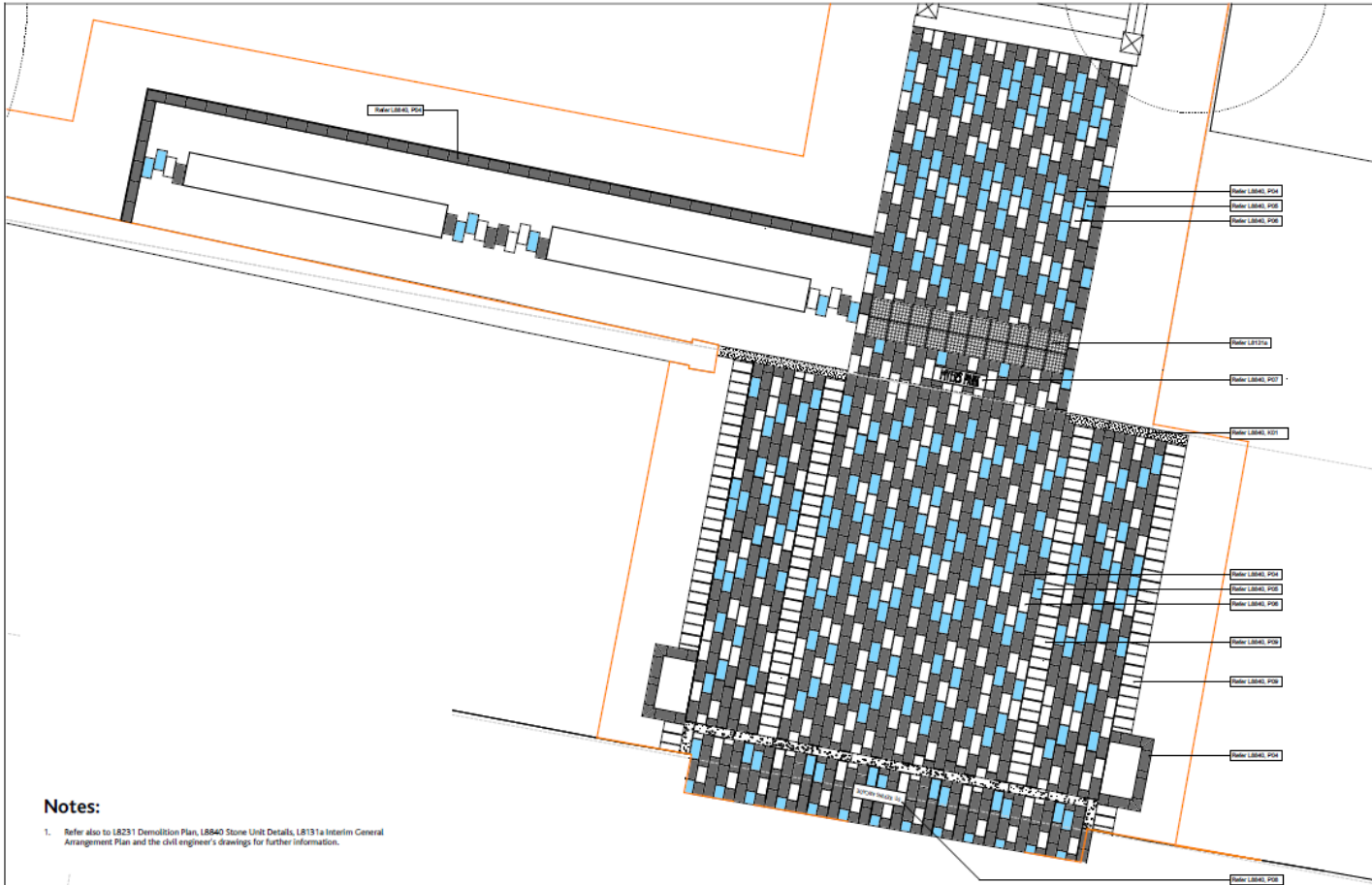
- Strong support for entrance upgrades, in particular the Mayoral Drive underpass and the Queen Street/Mayoral Drive stairs

Objectives

- Improve the streetscape environment by providing a legible, safe and attractive pedestrian crossing point between Myer's Park and Saint Kevin's Arcade.
- Balance the space allocation between cars and pedestrians.
- Create a “sense of place” that draws on both Myer's Park and Saint Kevin's Arcade.
- Improve safety through improved lighting.



Timeframe

- Mana Whenua reach out: October and November 2017
- Design updates: Starting end of October
- Public consultation: End of 2017 and early 2018
- Construction: March to May 2018
