

2.1 Concept Plan

DESIGN ELEMENTS:

Improve connectivity:

- 1 Greenway link between Line Road and Taniwha Street
- 2 Pedestrian path connection from Line/Epping Neighbourhood into reserve and on to town centre
- 3 Provide new bridge and secondary path that allows people to loop around the northern half of the reserve
- 4 Provide a safe connection between Taniwha and Maybury Reserves (TBC)

Improve Safety and Surveillance

- 5 Manage vegetation to improve sight lines at entrance and within reserve
- 6 Light greenways link
- 7 Bollard road frontages at Epping Street, Taniwha Street and Line Road

Improve Biodiversity and Water Quality

- 8 This wetland design is based on the most recent Auckland Healthy Waters Unit Project for Taniwha Reserve.

Reaffirm and Revitalise Mana Whenua Identity

Develop Te Aranga Design Principles in collaboration with Mana Whenua (refer to page 6)

- 9 Work with Mana Whenua to develop planting plans for the revitalisation of stream and native ecosystem (Taiao and Mauri Tu)
- 10 Work with Mana whenua in developing reserve naming and signage (Whakapapa)

IMPROVE PARK AMENITY

- 11 Open grassed areas for passive recreation
- 12 Park furniture: picnic tables, park benches and rubbish bins
- 13 Additional path, boardwalks/lookout platforms to engage with the stream and wetland
- 14 Lookout platform over outlet structure

Land to be transferred into reserve to provide new connection to residential neighbourhood
