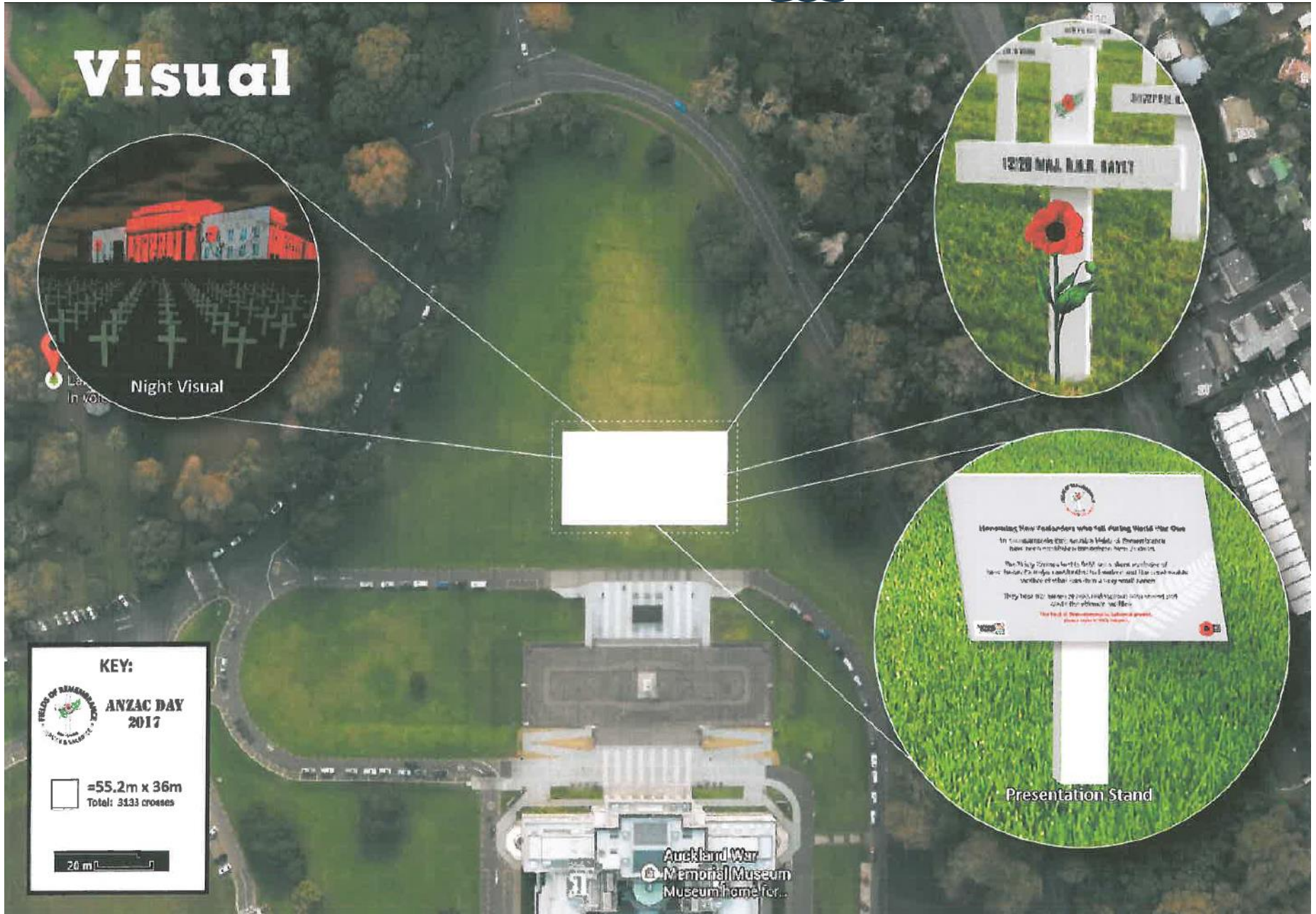

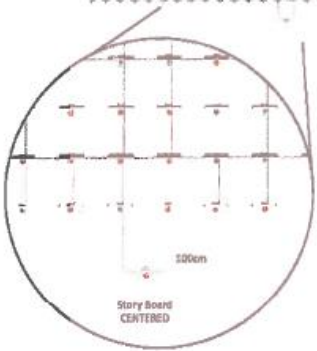
CROSS LAYOUT - ANZAC DAY AUCKLAND 2017

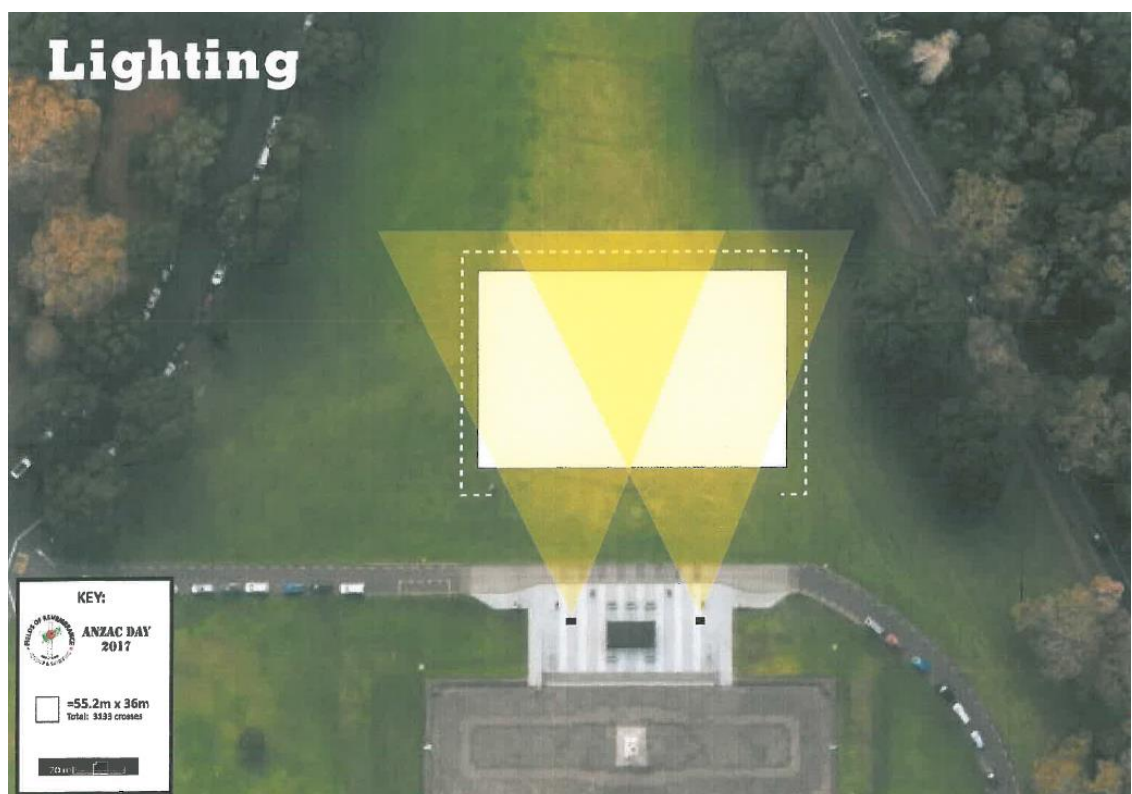
