What activities / programmes / events weren't successful within this quarter? Why?

A new Youth Boxing group which is free to local residents aged 11+ has been launched with funding from KLB - this is seeing an average of 16 people attending each week. This new initiative is in lieu of a Youth Club event at the Centre and is designed to bring together local teenagers in a focused and positive way.

A new day time Tai Chi class has started up this quarter and is proving popular

The first of planned regular "table top games" nights have been hosted - another free event for local residents, these will be held bi-monthly at this stage as we build interest.

A local resident has been offering sessions for new entrants to the local school to get together so the children and parents can meet each other. These have been running every 6 weeks or so and been popular.
