

## 4.7 Connections and Views

A key element of the masterplan update is improving connections. This sheet shows the network of shared paths and walkways within and around the park, creating access through currently separate residential blocks and open spaces.

The primary network of shared paths provide connections to the Awakeri Wetlands, Bruce Pulman Park and the wider Takanini area for pedestrians and cyclists.

Primary nodes mark the entrances to the park, while secondary nodes provide interpretation and wayfinding opportunities.

The secondary system of 1.8m wide gravel footpaths opens up the park, allowing visitors to discover the rich wetland and riparian habitats and to move between passive and active recreation spaces.

The changes in elevation across the park is a unique feature in the otherwise relatively flat catchment. The plan shows areas where these viewshafts across the landscape are the most prominent, allowing users to enjoy the views from proposed timber platforms or pause points along the path.
