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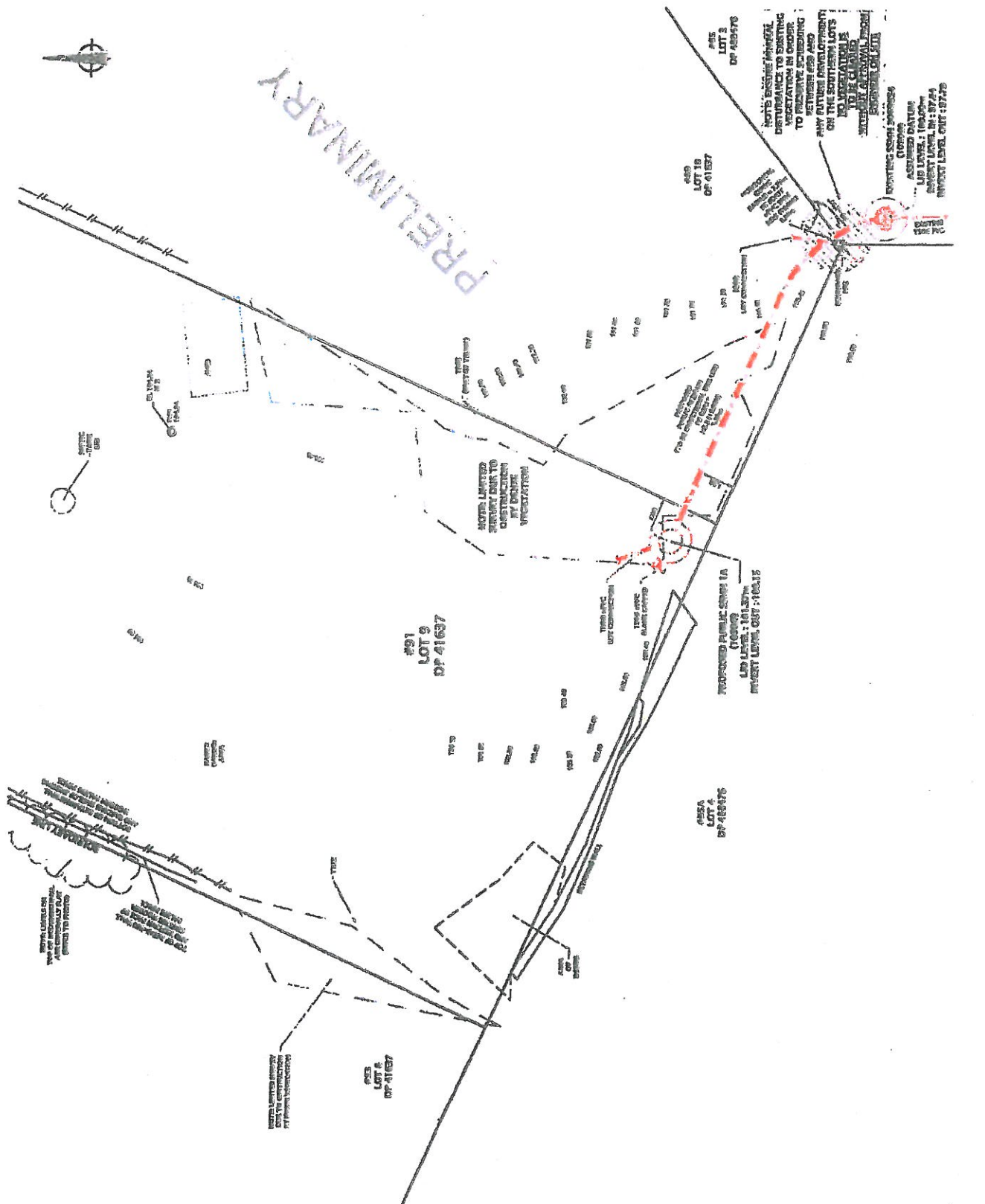

Alternative routes considered

The existing public wastewater drainage in the vicinity and proposed location of the wastewater connection are depicted in red on the following extract from Council's GeoMaps database:

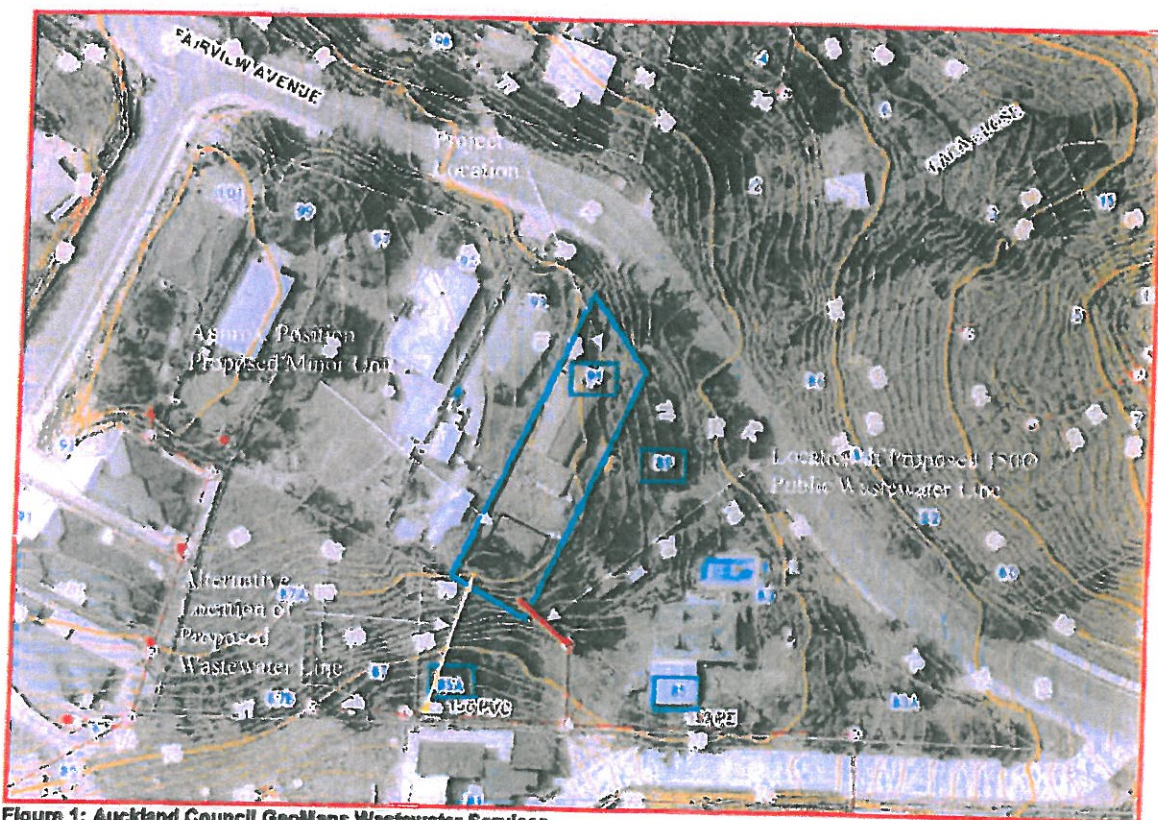


Figure 1: Auckland Council GeoMaps Wastewater Services

The only other available alternative route for the proposed drain is directly through No. 85A to the existing public line that traverses that site adjacent to the south boundary (shown in yellow above). This option is not considered feasible because there is potential conflict with a new building site.

In order to connect to the existing manhole in No. 85 it is necessary to traverse three neighbouring properties. The immediate adjoining owner of 89 Fairview Avenue (Mary Doyle) has provided her written consent to the proposal.

You have previously advised that you speak also for the owner of 85A Fairview Avenue and that they also do not give permission. Please advise if this is correct.

In conclusion, we reiterate our request for you to reconsider your position and we invite you to contact the undersigned to discuss further.

Please confirm receipt of this letter and we respectfully request that you respond with your decision within two weeks of receiving this information.
