The RBS are getting Victoria St surveyed and carrying out initial weed clearance and maintenance work on the first 50m section. The greenway route starts at Browns Rd, and follows the river bank in the Puhinui Scenic Reserve, from here it reaches the Lawrie Rd / Hamilton Rd intersection via Duck Creek Rd.
