It is a requirement by legislation to refresh the plan every six years and the draft will be going out for public consultation towards the end of the year.  Comments from local board members included electronic rate notices, the ability to opt out of receiving such things as Our Auckland in hard copy, the location of managed landfills and cleanfills, partnering with recycling industries, the reduction of plastic bags to landfill and educating the private sector about waste disposal.
