Letter of Apology,

Fulton Hogan would like to apologise for not following the full procedure while spraying on Great Barrier Island on the 27/11/2017 on Aotea Road.

Before spraying any chemical we are to follow the procedures as below:


- Notify residents who are on the spray notification register held by Auckland Transport
- Advertise on Barrier Bulletin 2 weeks in advance to notify the local residents on where and when we will be spraying.
- Have correct signs up warning the pedestrians and road-users of our spraying operations and signs to remain on site during the recommended withholding period of chemical being used, or minimum of 24 hours.
- No spraying around schools unless schools are closed.

We acknowledge that Fulton Hogan had not followed some of these procedures, and we have mitigated the issues and had a thorough discussion with the Fulton Hogan crew to make sure that all procedures are followed and also looking into usage of organic herbicide where appropriate going forward.

Once again we sincerely apologise for any inconvenience caused by our spraying operation.
