In accordance with Standing Order 3.11.1, I hereby give notice that I wish to move the following motion at the 14th December 2017 meeting of the Upper Harbour Local Board:

Recommendations

That the Upper Harbour Local Board:

- a) *Opposes the sale of any and all parts of Hobsonville Marina (West Park) and that the said area remain is Auckland Council ownership.*
- b) Does not support the development plan proposed by Panuku Development and does not consider the proposed plan to be in the public interest or in the interest of the West Harbour community.

Background

1. The board considers the marina to be an important public facility in one of the fastest growing areas of Auckland. There is no significant public benefit in the plan or the proposed sale of the freehold. The matter was brought to the board as a confidential item which excluded the public from any knowledge of the proposal to sell the marina or the proposed development plan. There is demonstrated opposition from the west harbour community and marina berth holders once the matter became public knowledge.
