Lions Warkworth – interpretative signage on Mahurangi Riverbank	Mr Buckton and Mr Little of Warkworth Lions were in attendance to outline a proposal for interpretative signage depicting historical sites and people on the Mahurangi Riverbank in Warkworth.	The representatives from the Lions Club in Warkworth were encouraged to work with council's Strategic Broker in regard to the proposal.
Te Arai groups; Save Te Arai Inc and Fairy Tern Trust	Ms Rogan of the Fairy Tern Trust and Mr McConchie of Save Te Arai Inc. were in attendance to outline various concerns in relation to Te Arai, and in particular the installation of weir which they consider has impacted on the food source of the Fairy Terns and altered water flow.	The weir is situated on a stream bed that is administered by Land Information New Zealand and they have requested that the developer, Te Arai North Limited, return the weir to its pre-2013 condition and upgrade the fish passage and erosion protection on the stream bank. This work needs to be completed by the end of January 2018.
