Subject: Urgent decision – Papakura Local Board submission to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Renewal of Licences) Amendment Bill (No 2) and the Supplementary Order Paper

Purpose

Seeking endorsement of the Papakura Local Board submission supporting the Auckland Council submission on the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Renewal of Licences) Amendment Bill (No 2) (the Bill) and the Supplementary Order Paper (SOP).

Reason for the urgency:

- The board's formal submission is to be attached to the Auckland Council submission which is being considered at the 10 April 2018 Environment and Community Committee meeting.
- The next Papakura Local Board business meeting is on 18 April 2018 which is after the 10 April 2018 Environment and Community Committee meeting.

Decision sought from the chair and deputy chair (or any person acting in these roles)

That the Papakura Local Board:

- a) **endorse the Papakura Local Board feedback on Supply of Alcohol (Renewal of Licences) Amendment Bill (No 2) (the Bill) and the Supplementary Order Paper (SOP).**

Background

1. The Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Renewal of Licences) Amendment Bill (No 2) amends the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by amending section 133 which addresses the renewal of licences where a relevant local alcohol policy exists.
2. The purpose of the Bill is to require the licensing authority and licensing committee to take a relevant local alcohol policy into account when considering the renewal of an alcohol licence. During the first reading on 21 February 2018, a Supplementary Order Paper was tabled. The SOP seeks to amend the Bill by limiting its application to only off-licence renewals.
3. The council has developed a local alcohol policy. The council's local alcohol policy is currently provisional and is not in force as it is subject to legal challenges. The Bill and the SOP would not affect the provisional local alcohol policy that has been developed by council, but may have implications for any future policy and the legal processes that are in progress.


