We are working alongside each other to support and grow networks and initiatives in the Kaipatiki area. 4 key strategic have been identified that the group would like to work on.

- 1- Green Waste
- 2- Asset map Kaipatiki as to where all places you can recycle items at
- 3- Drop off points – Drop off points for items such as batteries, mobile phones, polystyrene and toothbrushes will be available at community facilities.
- 4- Kaipatiki upcycle shed – This shed will be available for people to upcycle, re make with shared tools and maybe a shop

Member of the network will oversee different areas and meet monthly to update on progress.



Celebrating Communities' 2018 - 27 events put on by community for community. BBCP's role is to support local groups through marketing and support in putting on the events.



Community eats continues to run successfully. This programme is run only by volunteers. Since we started last August, we have given out 160 food boxes to the community and it continues to help support the connectives of the community.

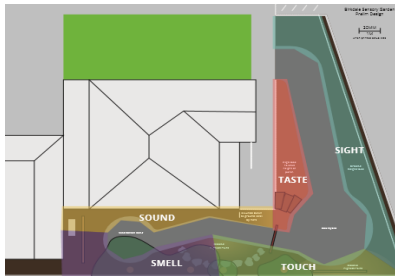
