

Schedule 4

Pool Costs and Usage Times

1. Hours of Use

- (a) The tenant shall have exclusive use of the indoor main pool and half of the junior pool during the days and times shown below. Good Friday, Christmas Day and mechanical failure or maintenance periods excepted.

- (b) The tenant shall give to the facility operator a schedule of the days they require use of the whole pool¹ within the first few weeks of each term.² The facility operator shall give the tenant full access and use of the whole pool on the advised dates and times. The tenant shall be invoiced for the use of the whole pool.
- (c) A maximum of five lanes will be available to the tenant at no charge if all swimmers are 16 years old and under.
- (d) The tenant shall give the facility operator at least 24 hours' notice if there is a demand for more lanes.
- (e) All swimmers over 16 years of age are subject to the council's Swimming Pool Pricing Policy.

2. Charges

- (a) Charges shall be set by council.
- (b) Entry cost is to be set by the facility operator as determined by the council's Swimming Pool Pricing Policy.
- (c) Lane hire charges: \$30 per hour (including GST), per lane, plus entry cost.
- (d) Junior pool: No cost for half pool usage.

¹ whole pool refers to all six lanes of the main pool.

² term refers to school term.

(e) Whole-pool hire charge: \$180 per hour (including GST), plus entry cost.

(f) Lifeguard provision outside of facility operating hours: \$25 per hour only.

Note:

All the above charges are to be paid to the facility operator.
