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## Subject: Alcohol ban request for Baddeleys and Campbells Beaches and Reserves

This memo completes the action requested from the Rodney Local Board on 19 April 2018 to:

- “a) defer the report for an alcohol ban at Baddeleys and Campbells Beach, Millon Bay, North Rodney and request that officers report back to the local board on clarification of the exact areas to be included in the ban.” (Decision RD/2018/30)

Staff recommended the area in Attachment A of the April report (Attachment A) following an inspection of the site and aerial photos. The recommended area is larger than area requested because it sought to:

- better reflect visual boundaries at both locations (e.g. the formed road in places is visually part of the adjoining park or beach areas)
- ensure all reasonably useable areas of recreational public open space are covered (e.g. clearings between mangroves or fringes of requested areas)
- to discourage displacement by ‘stepping’ just outside the requested area.

The recommended area in Attachment A includes:

- the boat ramps at Baddeleys Beach and Campbells Beach (see pictures below)



- a portion of the beach below the high tide mark.
- applies to the Christmas / New Year holiday period which is defined in the Bylaw as:  
“... Christmas Eve (the day before Christmas Day) to the day after New Year’s Day as determined by the Holidays Act 2003.

*Explanatory Note: As at 01 April 2014, section 45 of the Holidays Act 2003 specifies that where the public holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the public holiday must be treated as falling on the following Monday or Tuesday respectively.”*

It is not necessary to refer to specific dates in the decision. As part of implementation, staff will incorporate the definition in public communications.

The recommended area in Attachment A does not include:

- an area of grass and beach opposite 39 and 31 Baddeleys Beach Road because it was not shown in the request (see picture to right)
- an area at the eastern end of Campbells Beach Reserve shown in the request because it appeared to be unusable
- areas between Baddeley's Beach and Campbells Beach because the request did not show this area and provided no evidence of alcohol-related crime or disorder for the beach and bushy areas between the two beaches
- areas of the beaches to the low tide mark or below because the request did not show this area.
