Highly used by families.	<b>Prohibited</b> (to protect access)	No change to original assessment.
<b>Blockhouse Bay Recreation Res</b> 31-35 Terry Street, Blockhouse Bay	<b>Restricted - medium protection</b> (to protect access and health and safety)	Hardstand parking area of approximately 7,000m <sup>2</sup> spread over 4 areas. Clubhouses for tennis and bowls on site. Football fields, tennis, bowls and walking tracks through bush area. Toilets not 24/7.	Very busy area with general community use. Campers in the area would cause conflict.	<b>Prohibited</b> (to protect access)	Additional information from the board provided evidence of high use by locals and visitors to the area.
<b>Craigavon Park</b> 82-86 Kinross Street, Blockhouse Bay	<b>Restricted - medium protection</b> (to protect access and health and safety)	Hardstand parking area of approximately 800m <sup>2</sup> provides parking to walking tracks through bush area, playground and off leash dog area. Toilets not 24/7.	Park is a very busy dog off leash area. New parking area, already receiving complaints that there is a traffic issue in the area.
