Great South Rd 274 Manurewa	Great South Road - Manurewa	From January 1862 Lieutenant-General Duncan Cameron, commander of the Imperial forces in New Zealand, deployed every available soldier to clear bush and fell trees for the construction of the Great South Road. Each regiment was responsible for a section of the road and bonuses were offered for every cubic yard of scoria (hard volcanic rock) moved. On average 1700 men worked on the road each day... From 1863 to 1864 about 14,000 colonial troops marched down Great South Road from the Albert Barracks, in Auckland Central, and camps at Penrose, Otahuhu and Drury for the invasion of Waikato. Mr Prevost had already begun development in this direction before he sold the property, having cleared land for the tennis court, stable block and swimming pool. Prior to Mr Prevost owning the property, it had changed hands several times. It was sold to the Manurewa Land Company by the Cowley brothers, and apparently acquired the name "Totara Park" from the land agent in charge of the sale, Enos S. Pegler.
