Construction is planned to begin in October, with completion by the end of 2018.</p> <p>The board provided the following feedback:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Talk to the Papakura Business Association about potentially expanding the CCTV camera to the Takanini train station. 2. Please ensure the Māori spelling of Takanini is correct on the signage – Tākanini or Taakanini or a plinth be erected to reflect the Māori history of the area and Tākanini name. 3. A conversation with Te Ākitai about whether they want a historical presence at the Tākanini train station and if so, invite them to a workshop to enlighten the board on the history.
