Omaha Beach Polo proposal	Amy Calway was in attendance to outline a proposal to hold a beach polo event at Omaha	Ms Calway will need to submit an application to hold the event and go through the process required.
Mahurangi Community Sport and Recreation Collective	Mark Ilingworth and Gerard van Tilborg were in attendance to give an update on the activities of the Mahurangi Community Sport and Recreation Collective	The local board was able to advise that it has allocated \$150,000 in its work programme budget towards the design of the first stage of the multi-sport building.
Mahurangi East Tennis Club – request for renewal of lease	Representatives from Mahurangi East Tennis Club were in attendance to request a renewal of their lease and to give an update on the activities and aspirations of the club	The lease renewal for the Mahurangi East Tennis Club was the subject of report to the local board at the June business meeting.
