RE: TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC ACCESS TO FORT TAKAPUNA HISTORIC RESERVE

This letter is in regard to your request, as per Clause 6, Schedule 3 of your concession AK-27255-SSE, for NZ Sculpture Onshore Limited to temporarily close public access to the Fort Takapuna Historic Reserve from 24th October 2018 to 20th November 2018.

Your request has been approved.

As per Clause 7, Schedule 3 of your approved concession, NZ Sculpture Onshore shall pay the costs for placing a notice in the newspaper relating to the closure of historic reserve. We propose to advertise the closure of the reserve in once in both the Devonport Flagstaff and North Shore Times, two and four weeks respectively before the closure of the reserve.

Clause 5, Schedule 3 relating to charging entry fees for the sculpture exhibition also requires the approval of the Department. I also approve the charging of a \$15 entry fee for the 2018 exhibition. Please advise if there is to be a higher fee for this year's exhibition.

Please note that Clause 8, Schedule 3 requires you to gain approval from Auckland Council (previously the North Shore City Council) for use of the Fort Takapuna Recreation Reserve. I understand you have already submitted an application to Auckland Council for this year's event.
